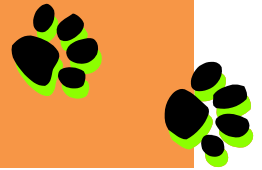

IMPORTANT .. 6TH GRADE PARENTS .. IMPORTANT

For all students entering the 7th grade, it is required by law that the school district report their immunization status to the local health department. With that being said, all children who attend school in Michigan are required by state law to be fully immunized to their standards. I have attached a document below that reviews Michigan's vaccination requirements for school. Please review your child's immunization status with their Physician as soon as possible to ensure compliance. Note that the Meningococcal and Tdap vaccinations are required for children 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade. If you have a personal objection to immunizations, please contact the Livingston County Health Department ASAP to set up an appointment to obtain a certified immunization waiver, 517-546-9850. If your student is not fully immunized in accordance with the Michigan law OR does not have a certified immunization waiver on file by the first day of the 2019/2020 school year, they will be excluded from attending Scranton Middle School until compliance is met. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or to inquire about the current record of your student's immunization status.

**BYBSP 2ND -8TH GRADE HITTING CLINIC 2019 WITH COACH
CHRISTNER, BRIGHTON VARISTY BASEBALL COACH AND STAFF**

Dates are; January 5th, 12th, 19th, and 26th, February 2nd, 9th, 16th, and 23rd and March 2nd and 9th.

Players will learn the fundamentals of hitting from Coach Christener and his coaches. This year's clinic will be available to anyone interested grades 2nd – 8th. The clinics will take place on Saturdays at Maltby Intermediate School. Each session is 40 minutes and will have a maximum of 6 players. There will be 2-3 coaches at each session, so your child will receive a great deal of one on one coaching during their session. You may sign up your child for as many Saturdays as you would like. Cost is \$20.00 per session.

Forty minute sessions each Saturday morning – 9-9:40, 9:40-10:20, 10:20-11, 11-11:40 am.

PARENTS VACCINES REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL ENTRY IN MICHIGAN

Whenever children are brought into group settings, there is a chance for diseases to spread. Children must follow state vaccine laws in order to attend school. These laws are the minimum standard to help prevent disease outbreaks in school settings. The best way to protect your child from other serious diseases is to follow the recommended vaccination schedule at www.cdc.gov/vaccines. Talk to your health care provider to make sure your child is fully protected.



	All Kindergarteners and 4-6 year old transfer students	All 7th Graders and 7-18 year old transfer students
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTP, DTaP, Tdap)	4 doses DTP or DTaP 1 dose must be at or after 4 years of age	4 doses D and T or 3 doses Td if 1st dose given at or after 1 year of age 1 dose Tdap at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher
Polio	4 doses 3 doses if dose 3 was given at or after 4 years of age	
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)*	2 doses at or after 12 months of age	
Hepatitis B*	3 doses	
Meningococcal Conjugate (MenACWY)	None	1 dose at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher
Varicella (Chickenpox)*	2 doses at or after 12 months of age or Current lab immunity or History of varicella disease	

During disease outbreaks, incompletely vaccinated students may be excluded from school. Parents and guardians choosing to decline vaccines must obtain a certified non-medical waiver from a local health department. Read more about waivers at www.michigan.gov/immunize.

*If the child has not received these vaccines, documented immunity is required.
All doses of vaccines must be valid (correct spacing and ages) for school entry purposes.

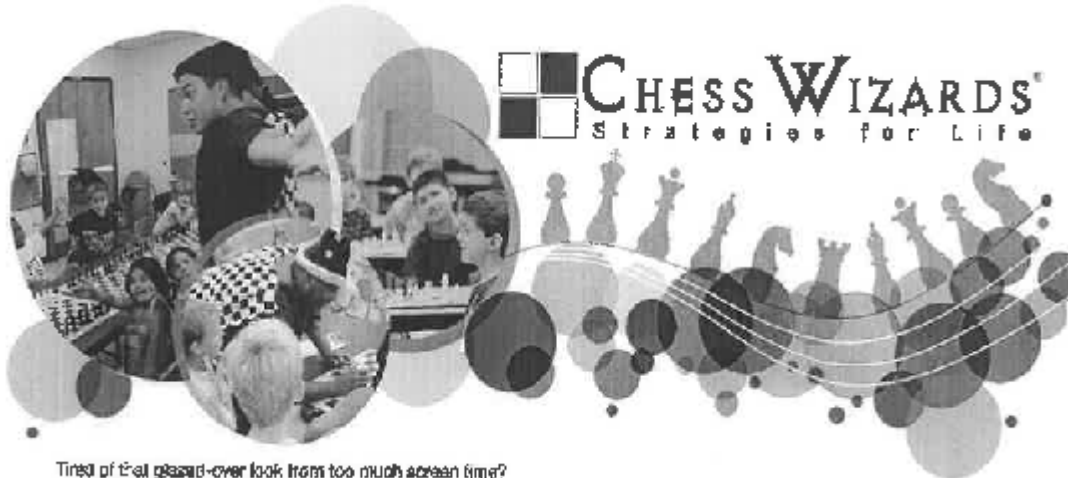

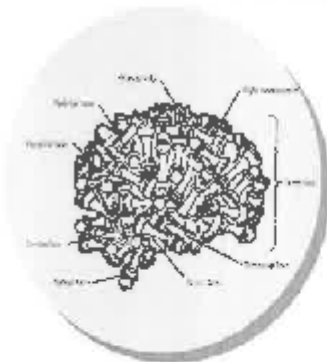
