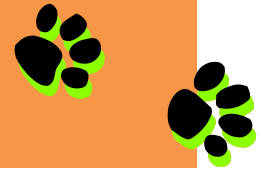

### BYBSP 2<sup>ND</sup> -8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE HITTING CLINIC 2019 WITH COACH CHRISTNER, BRIGHTON VARISTY BASEBALL COACH AND STAFF

Dates are; January 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 23<sup>rd</sup> and March 2<sup>nd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

Players will learn the fundamentals of hitting from Coach Christner and his coaches. This year's clinic will be available to anyone interested grades 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>. The clinics will take place on Saturdays at Maltby Intermediate School.

Each session is 40 minutes and will have a maximum of 6 players. There will be 2-3 coaches at each session, so your child will receive a great deal of one on one coaching during their session. You may sign up your child for as many Saturdays as you would like. Cost is \$20.00 per session.

Forty minute sessions each Saturday morning – 9-9:40, 9:40-10:20, 10:20-11, 11-11:40 am.

Flyers are in the Maltby office. Ask your student to pick one up if they are interested.

## Attendance & Office Procedures

If your student is going to be absent from school please use our convenient twenty-four hour absence call-in line **(810) 299-3688**.

-Please obtain a doctor's note to receive a medical "M" code for attendance.

- Please call when your student will be coming in late.

- You must call in each day that your child is absent.

-Please call no later than 9:00 a.m. on the day of the absence.

- Students arriving late to school **must** report to the office to sign in.

- Please send in a note for early dismissal and have it signed by office personnel.

**- We will only allow students to be signed out by people who are listed on the emergency card.**

- We will not release your child to anyone that is not listed on the emergency card unless advance notice is received from the parent (including older siblings).

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
