BYBSP 2ND -8TH GRADE HITTING CLINIC 2019 WITH COACH CHRISTNER, BRIGHTON VARISTY BASEBALL COACH AND STAFF

Dates are; January 5th, 12th, 19th, and 26th, February 2nd, 9th, 16th, and 23rd and March 2nd and 9th.

Players will learn the fundamentals of hitting from Coach Christener and his coaches. This year's clinic will be available to anyone interested grades $2^{\text{nd}}-8^{\text{th}}$. The clinics will take place on Saturdays at Maltby Intermediate School. Each session is 40 minutes and will have a maximum of 6 players. Attendance & Office Procedures
