

TICKS ARE HERE



ALL 6TH GRADE PARENTS/GUARDIANS

For all students entering the 7th grade, it is required by law that their immunization status be reported to our local health dept. With that being said, all children who attend school in Michigan are required by state law to be fully immunized to their standards. Please review your child's immunization status with their Physician prior to the start of the 2018-2019 school year to ensure compliance. Note that the Meningococcal and Tdap vaccinations are required for children 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade. If you have a personal objection to immunizations, please contact the Livingston County Health Department **as soon as possible** to set up an appointment to obtain a certified immunization waiver (517 546-9850).

If your student is not fully immunized in accordance with the Michigan law OR does not have a certified immunization waiver on file by the first day of the 2018-19 school year, THEY WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM ATTENDING SCRANTON MIDDLE SCHOOL until compliance is met. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.
