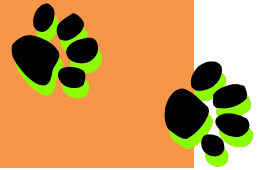

BHS FLU SHOT CLINIC THURSDAY, OCTOBER 12

- This clinic is open to **staff from 11 am - 2:30 pm** and then to anyone (≥3 years of age) in the **community from 2:30 pm - 5pm**
- CVS Pharmacy (inside Target) will be running the clinic
- They will be set up in the main office at BHS, near the clinic
- You will receive a **\$5 Target coupon** for getting your flu shot. You have to go to the pharmacy (located inside Brighton Target) in order to obtain the coupon.
- Bring your insurance card! Most insurance companies cover the vaccination in full
- If you don't have insurance, the vaccination cost is \$20
- Vaccinations are preservative free and will immunize you against 4 strains of the flu
- They will have an egg-free version of the vaccine available for those allergic to eggs

-Please call no later than 9:00 a.m. on the day of the absence.
