Snack Restrictions


This year we have a handful of food allergies including **nut** and **egg** allergies.

Parent Connect is the most efficient way to stay up to date on your child's grades. It updates in real time as we add to our gradebooks. Please check it often.



After a reminder or two to change a behavior students will receive a sign for:


- -Disruptive behavior
- -Off-task behavior
- -Having to return to lockers for forgotten materials
- -Late homework
 - 5 signatures Warning letter home and partial loss of DOGS time for the week
 - 10 signatures 30 minute after school detention and partial loss of DOGS time for the week
 - 15 signatures 1 hour after school detention and complete loss of DOGS time for the week

Students start fresh at the beginning of each trimester.

ELA

- We use the Lucy Calkins Reading and Writing Curriculum
- This curriculum is designed to develop skills in reading, writing, speaking, and listening.
- Reading:

Building an independent reading life

Fantasy Book clubs

Tapping the Power of Nonfiction

Social Issues book club

- Writing:
 - Personal Narrative
 - Literary Essay
 - Research Based Information Writing
- Grading:
 - Reading: Assessment 70%, Performance Tasks 25%, Practice Tasks 5%
- Writing: Assessments/Final Drafts 70%, Performance Tasks 25%, Practice Tasks 5%

AR

- Students are required to do independent reading of novels outside of those covered in class.
- Students are required to read outside the classroom in order to complete their book in the three week time frame.
- Students will take an AR test when they finish their books.
- Students are required to read level appropriate books based on their lexile score, which I will get from their NWEA test this fall.
- Students are asked to consider their reading fluency, pace, reading level, and time outside of school when choosing a book.
- Students will conference with me every week in library-this is a check in
- Students will fill out a weekly reading response in google classroom on the book they are reading.
- Students will need to complete 20 AR points by the end of the trimester for full credit.

Math

This year we will continue with the Everyday Mathematics Program.

Expect 2 homework assignments a night M-Th (Home Link and Math Boxes)

- Home Links practice new concepts. These are contained within a packet that each student will receive at the start of each unit.
- Math Boxes are found within the math journal and are primarily intended as recurring practice for past concepts.
- Homework is worth 10% of the total math grade.

Imagine Math

- Imagine Math is an online program that customizes learning pathways for the learner.
- Students will complete 2 lessons per week (or 1 if they are in MTSS)
- This is not intended to be homework
- Imagine Math is worth 10% of the total math grade. Missed lessons can't be made up for late credit.

Math Continued

Unit Tests make up 80% of the math grade

- Students may retake tests multiple times to improve scores. They may do so until the next unit test or the end of a the trimester (depending on timing).
- Tests will be displayed as "Learning Targets" when viewed on Parent Connect. Each test will cover several Learning Targets and each LT will be a separate grade.
- Students will usually take 2 tests per unit that assess 2-3 targets each.

Math Continued

Home Links, Math Boxes, the Family letter, and the SRB can be accessed via your child's Everyday Math Account online via the Clever portal.

We will also be using Khan Academy and Prodigy this year for enrichment and added review.

Geography

This year we will cover:

- Five Themes of Geography
- Cultural characteristics of the regions of Canada
- Consumption patterns in the United States
- The state of pollution in Great Lakes
- Causes and Effects of Urbanization in Mexico City
- Land use conflicts in the Amazon rainforest
- The European Union

Most classwork will take place in the virtual ISN (Interactive Student Notebook)

Grading is as follows:

- Tests and Major Projects 70%
- Mapping Labs, Journals, Classwork, and Homework 30%

Science

We will be using Mi-STAR Science this year. This is a student driven curriculum that is designed to match the scientific process. Students are given a question based on real world situations that they must create a solution to using information gained via experimentation.

Most student work will take place within our Google Science Classroom. I plan to utilize Google Slides as the main tool for recording work and notes.

We will study three units this year:

- The Water Cycle
- Investigating and Modeling Body Systems (Pathogens)
- Chemical Processes in the Digestion of Organisms
