March



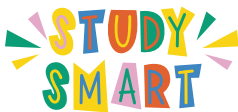
- Prepare for CAASPP testing

May



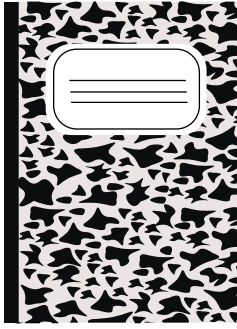
- AP testing
