

Union County Educational Services Commission requires that all students who need prescription or non-prescription medication (including Advil, Motrin and Tylenol) administered during school hours must, according to State regulation, do the following:

- 1. Submit the form completed by the physician and signed by the parent/legal guardian to the School Nurse.
- 2. Deliver medication in original packaging properly labeled by a registered pharmacist to the School Nurse.
- 3. Immediately notify the School Nurse of changes in dosage, administration or discontinuation of medication.
