AM - Arrival

Already in place

BEST Program/Homework Club/AM Extra Help (7:30am)

- Students are to enter the building through the doors leading to the main office.
- Students will be required to sign-in and designate the staff member they will be with.
- School secretary will have a list of students allowed to enter school for band, extra help, etc.

**All other students cannot enter the building until 8:00am.
NO EARLY DROP OFF PLEASE!**

Students arriving must use the cafeteria doors. The main office entrance will no longer be accessible.

Morning Monitors will be in the APR and Gymnasium at 8:00am.

PM - Dismissal

Students may only exit the building from two locations: the Main Entrance and the APR door. K - 8 students should not leave from any other location in the building.

Pre-school students will still enter and exit the building through the current designated locations.

34 cameras are located both inside and outside of building.

An average of 2 cameras are added per year.



Police have access to certain camera feeds from their car laptops and/or police station.

WAVE system - Panic buttons are located throughout the school and link directly to the police department.

Master key system for all interior and exterior doors. All police officers also have a master key.

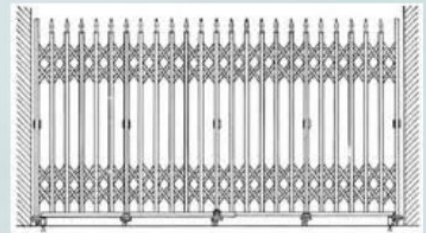
New windows installed with blinds that prevent sight into the classroom from outside the building.

Increased access to cameras for real-time use by Police and County dispatch.

In Planning

School Resource Officer (SRO) or police officer in building on a full time basis (2018/2019).



Install cement planters or bollards to prevent vehicles from accessing doors where students enter and exit the building.

Install fencing around playground areas.

Installation of shades on classroom doors for use during lockdown drills.



Parent Support Areas

Students should not be dropped off before 8:00am except for students involved in AM programs.

No parking in the fire lane only as a last resort if no parking spots are available.

Do not leave car running and unattended.

Parking is permitted on Union Lane after 3:00pm and on weekends - please use these spots during night and weekend events.

Do not linger in the APR after picking up children; please exit the building immediately.
