Dear Parent/Guardian:

With the new school year approaching, I would like to provide you with some information regarding parking for Seniors & Juniors for the 2024-2025 school year. Please use this [Parking Map Link](#) for specific parking lot locations for students and staff. This [Traffic Flow Link](#) is available for all student-drivers as well as walkers from the DYW Lot.

Parking applications are now available online using this [Google Form Link](#). We will process applications in the order they are received. Students will be contacted at their DASD email address once permits are available for pick-up, starting on **Monday, August 19th**. Please check Schoology and Dr. Barker's email blast for updates. Parking is limited, and both Seniors and Juniors will have the opportunity to purchase permits on a first-come, first-served basis. Permits **may not** be available later in the school year. Students may not park on campus until they have obtained a parking permit.

Each student is limited to registering only **one vehicle**. To be eligible to obtain a parking permit, students must have:

- All outstanding obligations cleared, including device fees.
- Copies of the following information at the time of permit pickup:
 - **Valid driver's license**
 - **Copy of the [Parking Rules and Regulations](#) signed by the student and a parent**
 - **Current vehicle registration and insurance card**
- Paid the parking fee of **\$50.00** on their PaySchools account. **You MUST SUBMIT PAYMENT before PERMIT PICK-UP.**

- [SENIORS ONLY] A copy of their 11th-grade physical on file with the Nurse.
- [SENIORS ONLY] Graduation Project presented (or scheduled to present).
- [JUNIORS ONLY] Graduation Project proposed by November 2024.

For any parking violations, a \$25.00 parking ticket will be issued, or the car will be towed at the owner's expense. Temporary parking passes are only issued for a second vehicle in an emergency to students who currently possess a parking permit. If there is a need to bring a different car on campus, students must obtain a temporary parking pass from Mrs. Karpe in the Main Office.

NOTE to Parents of JUNIORS: After entering into a contract with DYW to continue the use of their facility for the 2024-2025 school year, DASD has added lights, cameras, and paved the walkway from the DYW facility to our school campus. Due to these improvements, we will require all Juniors to purchase a school-issued parking permit for the DYW Lot at a rate of \$50.00. As a reminder, students without a parking permit are not permitted to park in the DYW Lot.
