

2024 - 2025 DRESS CODE

Boys and Girls Wear

Long pleated or flat front style dress pants, knee-length chino twill shorts, approved skorts, *no* skirts, or capri pants. Pants are solid colors: khaki, sand, or black - straight leg or boot cut. Jeans/colored jeans are not considered day to day dress code.

A skort with the HF logo are the approved options and are only available from Dennis Uniform, www.dennisuniform.com. Alterations to the skorts are *not* permitted. Skorts must meet the knee. Inappropriate skort length can result in the student being sent home until the issue is resolved.

Collared polo shirt, long or half sleeves with the Holy Family Logo on the left chest need to be worn every day.

Collared polo shirts **must be purchased through the official Holy Family High School Uniform Store:**

Gemini Imprints – <https://www.geminipromos.com/holyfamily> or **Dennis Uniform**. Collared polo shirts must be a solid color: Purple, Light Purple, Black, White, Navy Blue or Slate Gray. A shirt worn under the school polo which is visible must also be a solid color: Purple, Light Purple, Black, White, Navy Blue or Slate Gray.

Spirit sweatshirts, hoodies, and T-shirts (long or short sleeve) are *not* considered day-to-day dress code and may only be worn on spirit days.

No jackets (other than letter jackets), coats, or outside clothing are to be worn in the school between 8:00 a.m. and 2:45 p.m. These items are to be locked in lockers during school hours.

The following are *not* permitted; **Jogger style pants, leggings/yoga pants, stretch pants, athletic pants, cargo pants, low rise pants, or any tight or form fitting material, hats, scarves, wallet chains, dog collars, spikes, ear buds, and other such "additions"**.

Shoes should reflect safety and comfort; shoes must have a closed toe and an enclosed heel. Flip flops, slides, and slippers are *not* permitted.

Students with three (3) Dress Code violations will serve a Saturday detention.

Spirit Wear or Spirit Pack Items

Spirit wear or Spirit pack items are to be worn on Spirit Days only! Spirit Days are a privilege and are announced in advance. Students may wear Holy Family High School t-shirts, sweatshirts, or letter jackets, on which a Holy Family High School Spirit Logo is visible. These items must be Holy Family High School sponsored spirit wear; extraordinary embellishments are not permissible.

All shirts must have sleeves; cannot be midriff style, or tight fitting. Students may wear intact **jeans, or nice shorts (no gym shorts)** on Spirit Days. Jeans or shorts cannot be tight fitting or low rise, no sagging and may not contain holes, leggings/yoga pants are *not* allowed. If a Spirit Day is not announced, no spirit wear is to be worn.

Campus Wear

These are items worn to school sponsored activities on or off campus. Students should wear appropriate spirit dress attire or other appropriate attire. Mini-skirts, sleeveless tops, midriff tops, tight fitting, sagging, or low-rise pants are *not* acceptable.

Extraordinary attire, extraordinary hairstyles, colorings, shavings are *not* permitted. Boys are to be clean-shaven, a well-groomed mustache is allowed. Jewelry should be modest in appearance. Small stud nose piercings are allowed, however large studs, hoops, septum piercings or other visible piercings other than ears are *not* permissible. **Visible tattoos and other body modifications are *not* acceptable.**

In addition, alterations of the clothing, and the manner of wearing clothing, makeup, jewelry, and symbols that appear to be gang, cult or peripheral group related, as deemed by the school Administration, are prohibited.

The Administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate dress code or deem something extraordinary. The parents' vigilance and complete cooperation with the school administration in these matters are required.
