


DANCE EXPLORATION & DANCE ESSENTIALS

*Dance Exploration is not a performance-based class. Dance Exploration gives students in grades 6-8 an alternative option for learning that is different from the core movement classes of ballet, jazz, and modern. Dance Exploration will cover academic topics such as dance composition, dance etiquette, genres, history, movements, notable figures, and vocabulary.

*Dance Essentials gives students in grades 9-12 an alternative option for learning that is different from the core movement class of ballet, jazz, contemporary and modern. Dance Essentials will allow dancers to gain knowledge of job opportunities and navigate a career in the performing arts. During this course, students will create a resume, bio, artist CV, reel, website and social media platform, while budgeting for a big city and preparing for higher education. Dancers will understand the importance of versatility and the connections required to pursue a career in the performing arts.

• Pittsburgh CAPA Virtual Dance Department Audition Information

- Students will participate in three virtual portions of a dance audition:
- Virtual Group Technique Class: Students will participate in a dance class consisting of ballet, modern dance and jazz dance techniques
- Following the group technique portion, everyone will have a short break before beginning their solo and interview.
- Individual Solos: Students will perform a pre-choreographed one-minute solo in a chosen style. Choreography should show artistic potential and not include movement from dance apps or social media platforms. This movement must be planned and prepared by the student before the audition takes place.
- Interview: Students will have a short interview immediately after solo presentation.
- Platform:
- For all auditions, we will be using ZOOM. Students will receive an invitation to the audition prior to
 their scheduled audition date/time. Upon accessing the interview link, the student will be admitted
 from the virtual lobby/waiting room and all members of the audition panel will already be present.
 Students will be given one link for the group technique class and an assigned timeslot to log back in for
 the solo and interview portion of the audition.

- Audition Attire:
- Leotard and convertible tight, ballet shoes with elastic sewn and tie strings tucked in, barefoot for modern and jazz shoes for jazz. Long hair must be pulled back (bun preferred), no jewelry should be worn.
- Solid White T-Shirt with black tights or form fitting shorts, ballet shoes with elastic sewn and tie strings tucked in, barefoot for modern and jazz shoes for jazz. Hair must be neatly secured from the face.
- Scoring:
- Part One: Technique Out of 20 Points
- Part Two: Prepared Solo Out of 12 Points
- Part Three: Interview Out of 8 Points
- Total: 40 Points (Point categories include: Distinguished, Proficient, Basic, Unsatisfactory)
- Length of Audition: Though we are efficient in our audition process, the complete audition can take up to 3 hours total.

PREPARING FOR THE AUDITION

- Please be aware that the entire process can take up to three hours
- Be on the look out for "Audition Prep" Sessions
- Students should create a space that they can audition in that has little to no distractions.
 Being aware of space and all surroundings. Please be prepared with water, having used the restroom and taking care of additional duties before starting the audition class.
