

WINGS Academy Opens This Fall at Holden R-3

W.I.N.G.S. Academy is a program designed to meet the needs of students with barriers in the Holden School District. Our mission with WINGS is to provide students with an opportunity to earn high school credit through various methods of instruction while providing individualized support. This program aims to provide a space where students can foster resilience, positive communication, and fortitude. Students at WINGS Academy will be able to gain real-world encounters through job site experience and community service. WINGS Academy will also allow students to participate in career and life counseling. The goal at WINGS Academy is to provide students the ability to graduate from high school with their same-grade or similar-grade level peers with the capabilities to be successful in post-secondary life.

Fill Out the Free/Reduced Price Meal App - it Helps Everyone!

Completion of the **FREE/Reduced Price Meal Application** benefits families and the school district in multiple ways all families should apply even if they aren't sure if they would qualify. Participation rates directly impact a school's eligibility to receive state and federal funding, including grants, which provide valuable resources that play a key role in student success! In addition, students who qualify for benefits may also be eligible for:

- Discounted fees associated with applying for college
- Reduced fees for academic tests such as the ACT and AP exams
- Additional Scholarship Opportunities

If you filled out a form last year and your family qualified for free or reduced price meals, there is a grace period of thirty days from the beginning of the school year, during which your child(ren) will continue to receive those benefits. However, we recommend filling out the 2024-2025 form as soon as possible since it does take time to process. Visit holdenschools.org/mealapp to fill out a Free/Reduced Price Meal Application now to find out if your family qualifies for benefits. It's easy, and in addition to lowering (or eliminating) school meal costs and fees for your family, it helps the district qualify for special programs such as Free Summer Food for all kids 18 & under. If your family received a letter from the district stating you have already been qualified through direct certification, there is no need to fill out a form.

Day Plus, Holden R-3's Before and After School Program, offers high-quality care in a fun environment, helps with homework, and has a variety of engagement opportunities for students. Housed at Holden Elementary, the program operates on school days from 6:00am until 8:00am in the morning and from 3:00pm until



6:00pm in the morning and from 3:00pm until 6:00pm in the afternoon. Care is also offered on days when there is no school due to teacher inservice or during the summer, from 6:00am until 6:00pm. Day Plus accepts students in preschool through 5th grade and a variety of fee options are available for families on a limited budget.
