As reported on the 2018 Future Ready Index, City Charter High School (CCHS) did not meet statewide goals/interim targets on performance for the Black student group in all content areas; for the All, Black, Economically Disadvantaged (ED), and Student with Disabilities (SWD) student groups in Math and Science. The school showed declines for the All and Black student groups in all content areas; for every student group reported in Math; for the ED student group in Science.

The academic achievement gap has significantly increased on all content areas over the past three years: from 17.6 to 29.7 in ELA, and increase of 12.1percentage points; from 26.6 to 47.9 in Math, an increase of 21.3 percentage points; from 18 to 38.7 in Science, an increase of 20.7 percentage points.

CCHS did not meet statewide goals/interim targets for growth in Math for Black students.

The school did not meet the interim target for attendance for teh 2 or more races stuent group.

The school met or exceeded the statewide goal for High School Graduation for all student groups.

The school did not meet the interim target for the Career Standards Benchmark for the SWD student group.
