As reported on the 2018 Future Ready Index, the Provident Charter School (PCS) did not meet statewide goals/interim targets on performance for the All, Black, White, Economically Disadvantaged (ED), and Student with Disabilities (SWD) student groups in ELA; for the ALL, Black, (ED), and Student with Disabilities (SWD) student groups in ELA and Math; the All and SWD student groups in Science. The school showed declines in the All, Black, White, and SWD student groups in Math; the All, White, and SWD student groups in Science.

PCS did not meet statewide goals/interim targets for growth in the All, ED, and SWD student groups in Math.

The school met the interim target for Regular Attendance in all student groups.

The school met or exceeded statewide goal for the Career Standards Benchmark in all student groups.
