As reported on the 2018 Future Ready Index, the Urban Pathways K-5 College Charter School (UPK-5) did not meet statewide goals/interim targets on performance for the All, Black, Economically Disadvantaged (ED), and Student with Disabilities (SWD) student groups in ELA; the All, Black, and ED student groups in Math. The school showed declines in the All, Black, ED, and SWD student groups in ELA; the All, Black, and ED student groups in Math.

UACS did not meet statewide goals/interim targets for growth in the Black and ED student groups in Math.

The school did not meet the interim target for Regular Attendance in any student groups.

The school met or exceeded the statewide goal/interim target for the Career Standards Benchmark in all student groups.
