*Grades input on Grade Cut-off date MUST be for grades completed by Student Work Cut-off date or for make-up work completed within the deadline.

- Minimum number of grades for each grading period: 9 formative & 3 summative
- Grading Error Reports will be emailed to teachers on the last day of the grading period. All errors should be resolved before the grade input deadline.
- Student work cut-off date and time listed are for eligibility purposes. Teachers may assign earlier deadlines in compliance with WSISD Grading Guidelines.
- Academic eligibility is determined from nine-week grades, not semester grades.
- All students meeting the UIL requirements of promotion or earned credits toward state graduation are eligible the 1st six weeks of the year.
 - Freshman - student promoted from the previous grade
 - Sophomore - student has earned six (6) credits
 - Junior - student has earned twelve (12) credits or six (6) the previous year
 - Senior - student has earned fifteen (18) credits or six (6) the previous year
- After the 1st six weeks academic eligibility check, students may only lose academic eligibility at the nine-week grading period.
- Students can regain academic eligibility at the three and six week progress reports and at the nine-week grading period.
- All students are academically eligible during the Thanksgiving, Winter, Spring and Summer Breaks.
