CHARACTERISTICS OF A SUCCESSFUL STUDENT:

1. **Consistent attendance:** Every school day counts in a child's academic life. A missed school day is a lost opportunity for students to learn. Attendance is important because students are more likely to succeed in academics when they attend school consistently. It's difficult for the teacher and the class to build their skills and progress if students are frequently absent.
2. **Willing to Put Forth Effort/Perseverance/Self Motivated-** School is not easy. However, successful students are willing to put forth the effort to produce quality work at school and beyond. Students who perform best in school have a natural eagerness to learn new things. When kids learn to be proud of the work they do, they will stick with their tasks, even when they become hard or challenging.
3. **Respect** (to adults, other students and themselves) - Students need to learn not to take things that belong to others without asking first, and to treat other people's property with the utmost care. Respect is an important value to instill in children from day one since they will be called to these values on a daily basis in the classroom.
4. **Responsibility:** Students are responsible for their possessions, and behavior at school.
