ADJECTIVES are words that describe nouns, such as what they look like, feel like, sound like, taste like, or smell like.

ADVERBS are words that modify the verbs, to tell how, when, where, and how often.

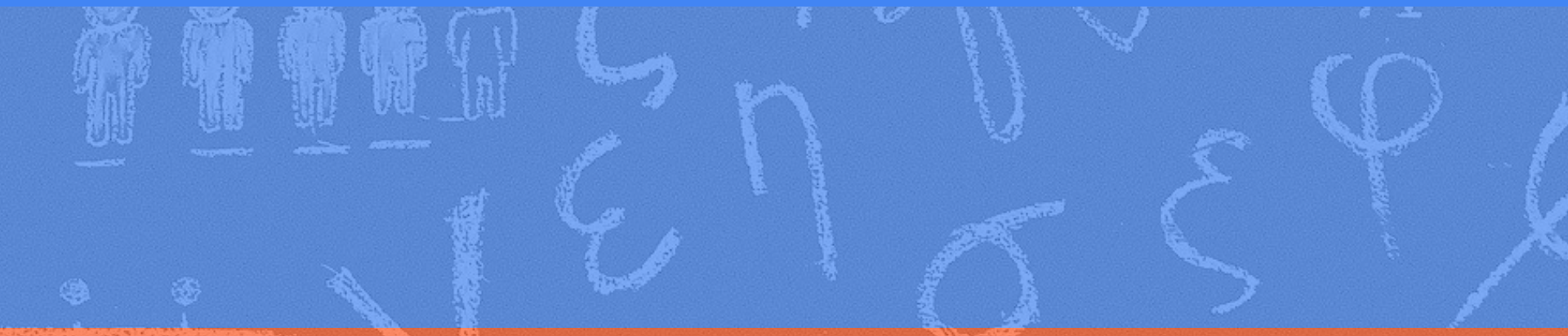

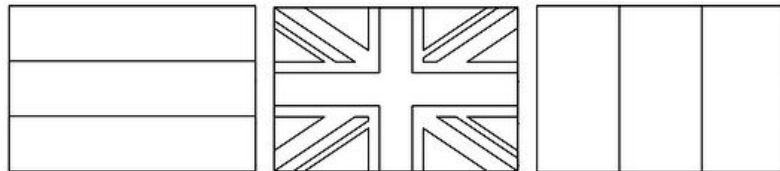
The Basics



Europe is one of the seven continents! It is in the northern hemisphere of Earth. Europe is the second smallest continent in the world. There are 50 countries. It is touched by three oceans. Europe connects to Asia. The Ural Mountains separate the two continents.

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Countries in Europe



There are 50 countries in Europe. The three largest countries are Russia, Ukraine, and France. Moscow is the largest city in Europe. Over five million people live in Moscow. Vatican City is the smallest city in the entire world.

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Landforms in Europe

Europe's land is the best land in the world for farming. More than half of the land is low, flat plains. All forests are evergreen. There are some mountains to the south. The Alps are rugged mountains. The Pyrenees are between Spain and France. There are glaciers in the north.



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Waterways in Europe



Europe has a lot of peninsulas. Many rivers run between and through the countries. The Danube River is the most used river. It runs through ten different countries. There are few lakes. Europe is bordered by the Arctic Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Mediterranean Sea, the Black Sea, and the Caspian Sea.

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People in Europe

About 746 million people live in Europe. This is about ten percent of the world's population. Many people travel to Europe to visit famous landmarks like the Eiffel Tower. Many different languages are spoken in Europe. Some of these are Russian, German, Turkish, and Italian. English is commonly spoken in Europe,

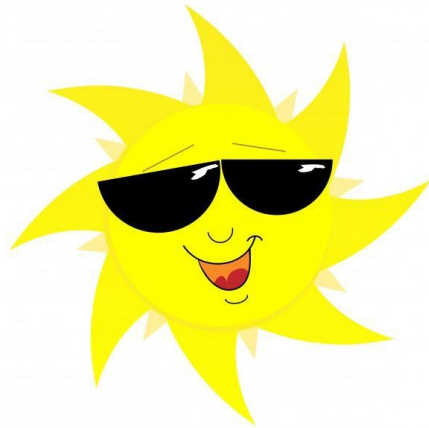
