TRANSPORTED STUDENTS

Please remember that MIDDLE SCHOOL students that are transported after school other than by bus must have a note on file in the office.

1. If a high school brother or sister is to take a middle school child home, then a note signed by a parent/guardian must be presented to the CMS office in the morning.

Other than the bus transportation, no students are permitted to ride home without written permission. Please remember to write a note for any changes in transportation. If you have questions or concerns about the bus schedule, please call Mrs. Van Horn at 330-482-5608.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS

As you begin to prepare for this school year, you will find the CMS student supply list at the local department stores, or outside of the Middle School office.

SCHOOL COMPUTERS

Crestview computers that students took home over the summer should be turned on and allowed to run updates the first week of August. If your student is experiencing any technical difficulties, please have them send a Help Ticket to the Tech Department so any issues can be addressed BEFORE the school year begins. Students will be expected to start the school year on the first day since they will have their computers prepared to use.

PARKING PERMITS

Student drivers **must** purchase a parking permit for the 2024-25 school year. The permits will be issued on a first come-first serve basis.

Parking spaces are numbered this year to know which vehicle belongs to which students, as part of our district safety plan.

ALL STUDENTS, INCLUDING CCCTC AND CCP STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PARK IN STUDENT LOT. THE PAC LOT IS ONLY FOR STAFF & VISITOR PARKING FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR.

Student Parking Forms are available online under the high school page, and should be completed as soon as possible.

Students must have the forms **authorized digitally by their parents, bring a copy of your valid driver's license, proof of insurance (copy for our records) and \$35.00** (cash or check payable to Crestview Schools) at the time of purchasing their permit. *This cost includes the students athletic pass for the 24-25 school year as well.* All student drivers must have a parking sticker and participate in the student random drug screening if they have not already done so as a student athlete.

CRESTVIEW HIGH SCHOOL

12th Grade Meningitis Requirement

This letter is to inform you of the **Immunization Requirements** for students entering 12th grade in the fall of 2024. Students are required to have: 2 doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine. If your child received the first dose of the vaccine after his/her 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.

We must have proof of these immunization (s) in order for your child to begin 12th grade. If your child has already received these immunization (s), please send a copy of the record to the school as soon as possible.

If your child has not received these immunizations, please contact your healthcare provider as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. It is important to plan ahead as it may be difficult to get an appointment closer to the start of school.

The Immunization Record must be received before **August 15, 2024**. Records can be mailed, faxed (330-482-5369) or hand delivered to the office.

Kindergarten Parents!

The first full day of school for your child will be on Friday, August 16th. However, August 15th will be used for individual appointments, which will allow our teachers to administer the KRA-R and the state diagnostic assessments. You should have received an email with your appointment information after Kindergarten Screening from Christy Hoopes, district secretary.

Pre School Parents!

You should have received your welcome letter from Columbiana County ESC if your child is enrolled in our preschool program! Please be sure that you signed & returned your commitment letter to CCEC. As indicated in the packet, the first day for preschool students is Tuesday, August 20th - please be sure to sign up through the link provided by CCEC for your time to meet the teacher & bring in supplies on the open house days!

Transportation- REMINDER

If your child will be a transport student at anytime throughout the year please be sure to upload the license plate number and driver name to your School Pass App. You may have multiple drivers, just be sure to include the plate number and names for all possible drivers.
