We watch each one more closely,



Nafumi Tamura is 18, and she is from Osaka, Japan. Her host family in St. Michael was the David Stoick family. She is an only child, so it has been a new experience for her to see the large families in this area. Her hometown, Osaka, is an industrial city with a population of about I million. Nafumi liked St. Michael and she thinks the small school has helped her get to know many people and make close friends. Nafumi said she noticed how many people are proud of their town and life here. In Japan, high school is not cumpulsory education (grade 9 is the last required grade). Japanese students are required to memorize more in some classes, while here practical elements are considered more important. Many Japanese customs have been Americanized, so there is not a lot of difference in lifestyles. There are, however, many traditions which effect subtle changes in daily life and ways of thinking. Nafumi likes it here very much and is glad she came to the United States.



Antonio Silva, who is 18, came to St. Michael from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. While here, he stayed with the Ammon Vetsch family. He likes football, surfing, swimming and camping, and is interested in studying engineering in the future.

Aurora Milla is 16, and she is from Guatemala. Her host family in St. Michael has been Mr. and Mrs. Tidmarsh. She had one brother and one sister in Guatemala. Aurora thinks her former school is more strict than STMA, and she thinks our teachers are really friendly. She felt that while food customs and prices are different here, her lifestyle has not generally changed much from the way she lives in Guatemala. Aurora said that she liked living in St. Michael.








### At Work And Play
