Boys Cross Country







The Knights wrestlers had a very fulfilling season this year. They won both the STMA and Monticello invitationals and placed 3rd at the Minnesota Christmas Tournament in Rochester, topped only by Apple Valley and Simley. Further into the season, they beat No. 2 ranked Scott West at the Farmington Dual Tournament to take yet another championship. Chas Betts (12) and Mike Thorn (10) were state champions, Jake Grygelko (11) was state runner-up, Brandon Dick (12) placed 3rd, John (12) and Joe (9) Grygelko both placed 4th, Chad Little (10) placed 5th, and Luke Vetsch (11) placed 6th. 




