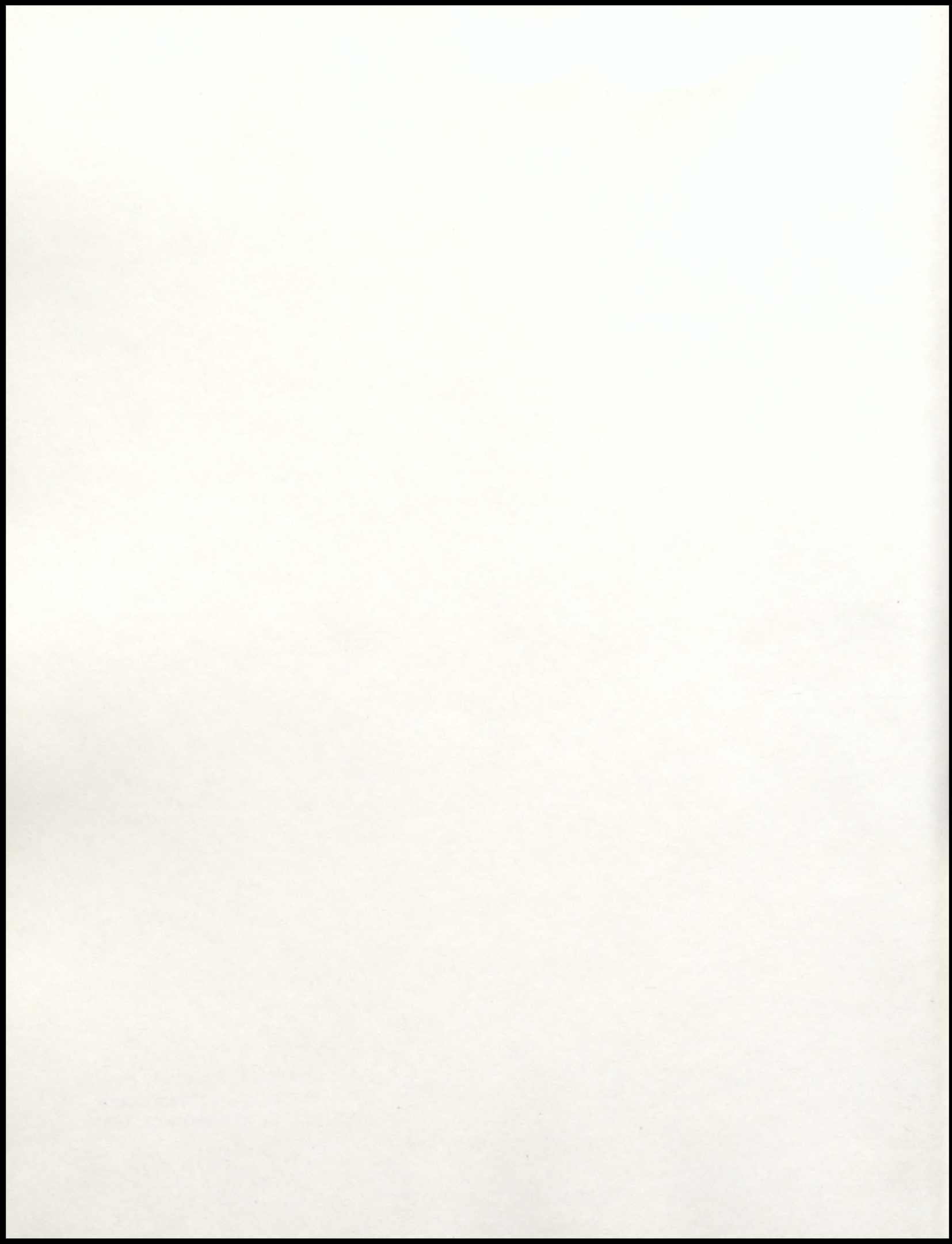

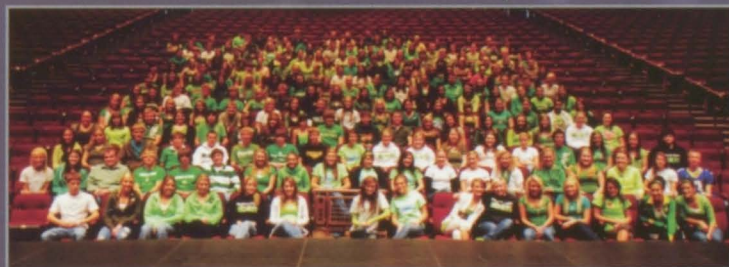
Today's The *Day*

Above: Annette pitching for the softball team.

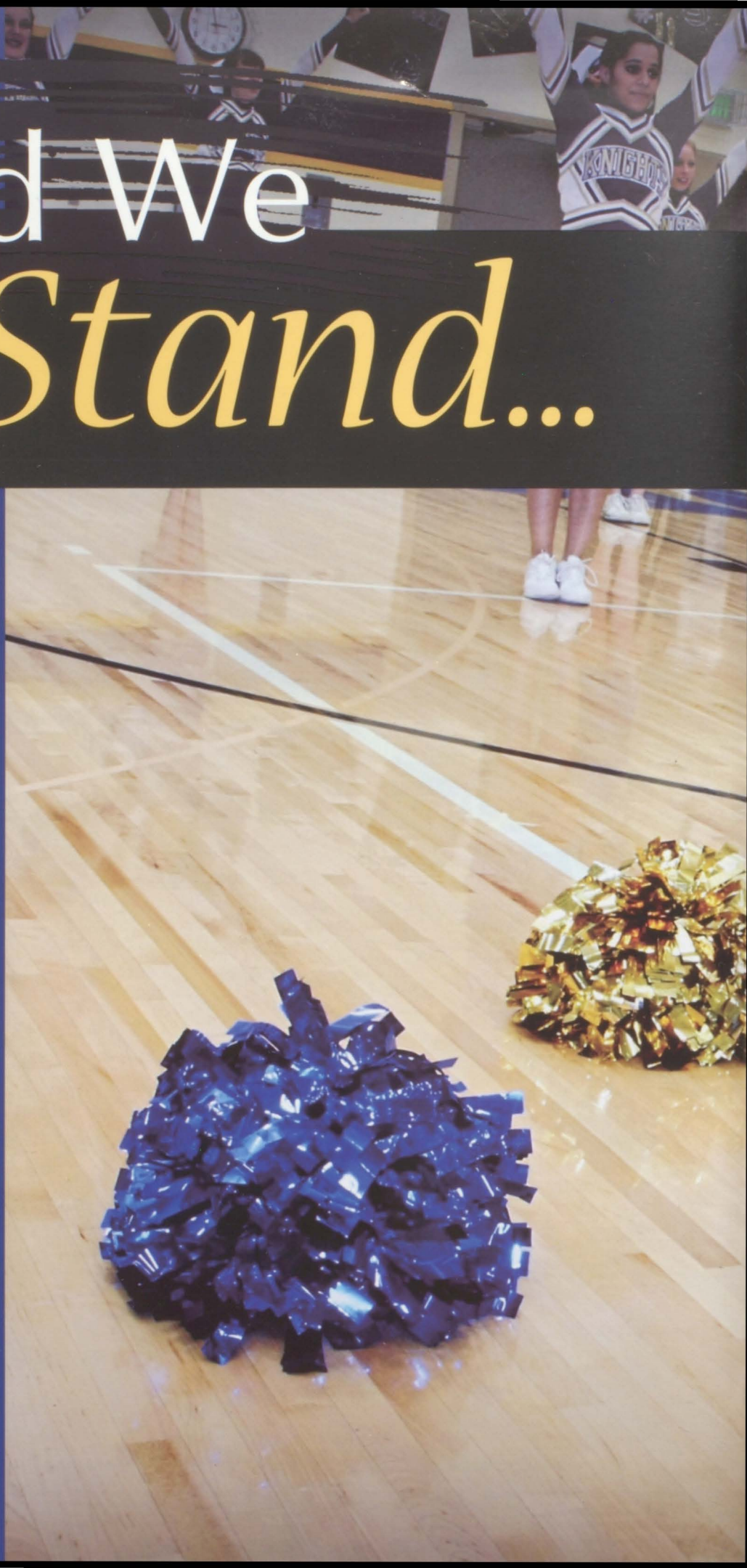

United We *Stand...*

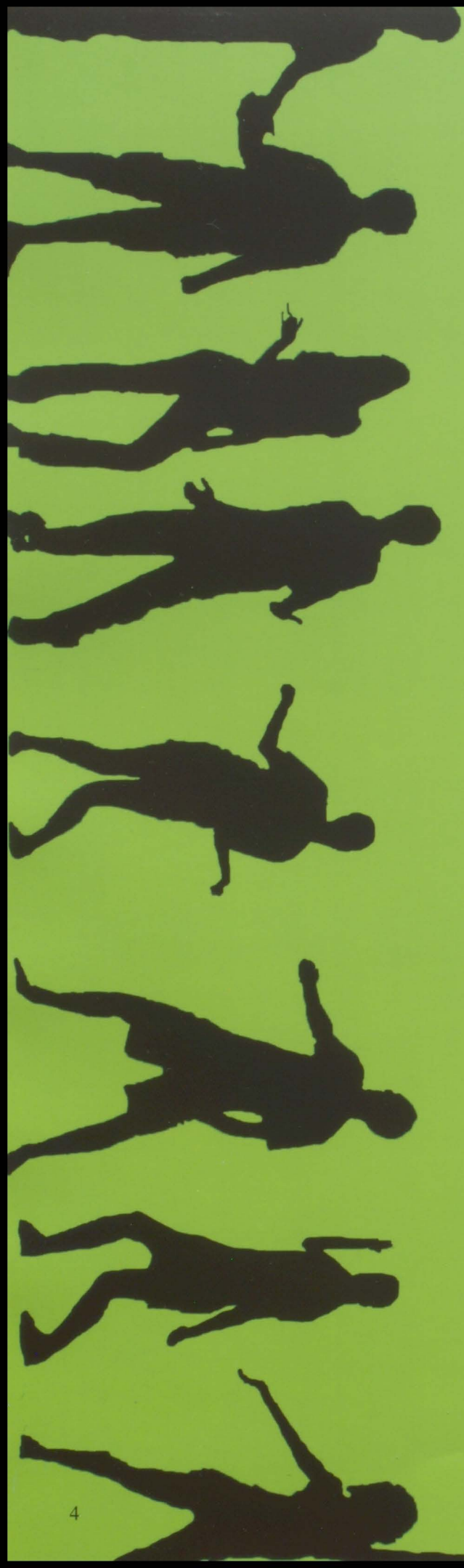

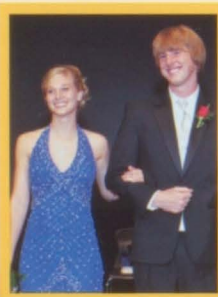

A MOMENT LIKE *this*

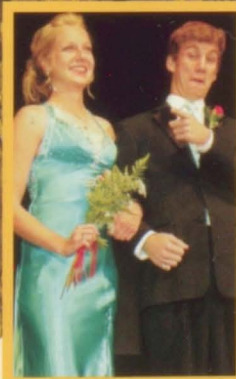

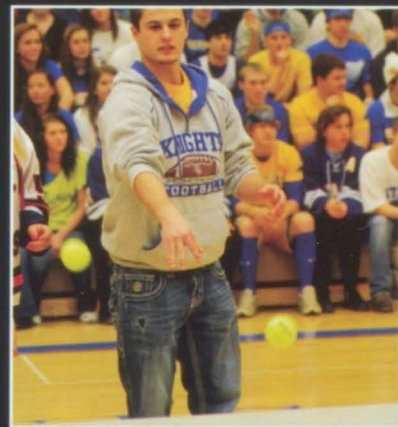

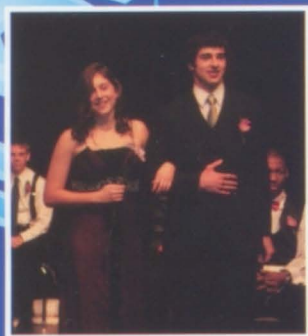
Let's Make New *Memories*

Beauty and the Beast

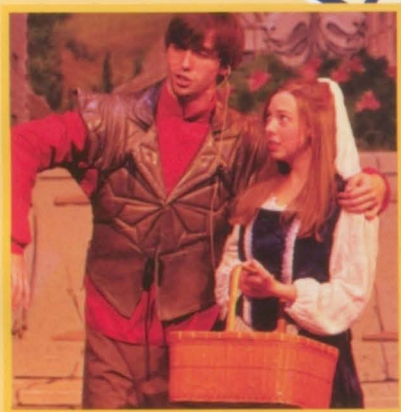

The play had a great team consisting of the pit orchestra, stage managers, stage crew, and directors; Mr. Zahler and Ms. Wichman.

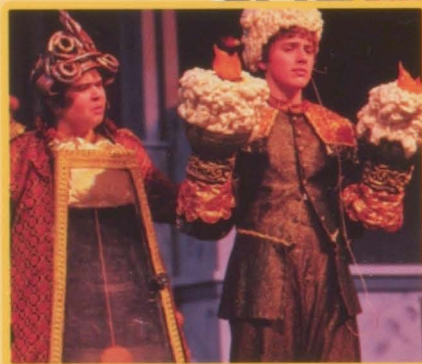

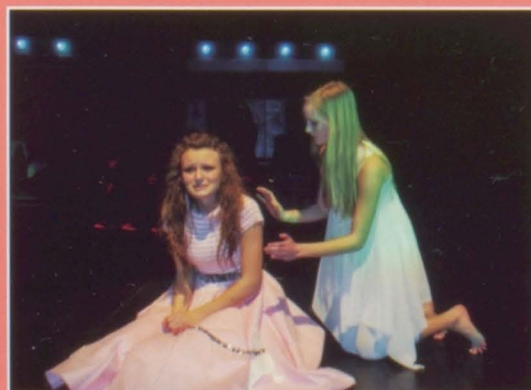
Last *Kiss*

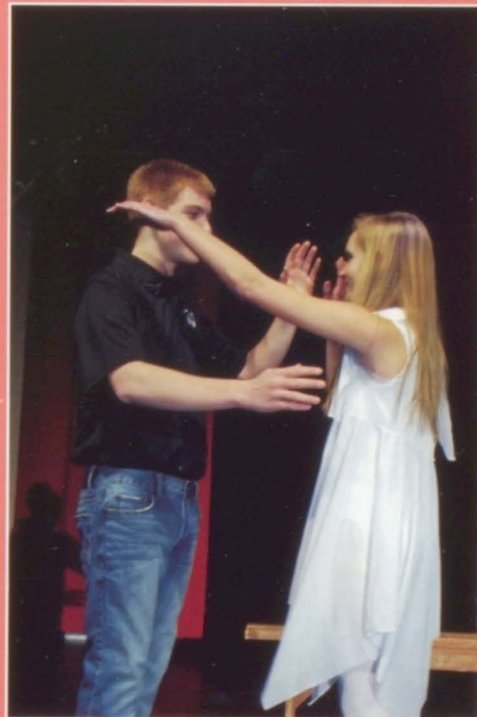

Good luck and thanks for your dedication to STMA schools, football, and the communities Coach Bauman you will truly be missed.

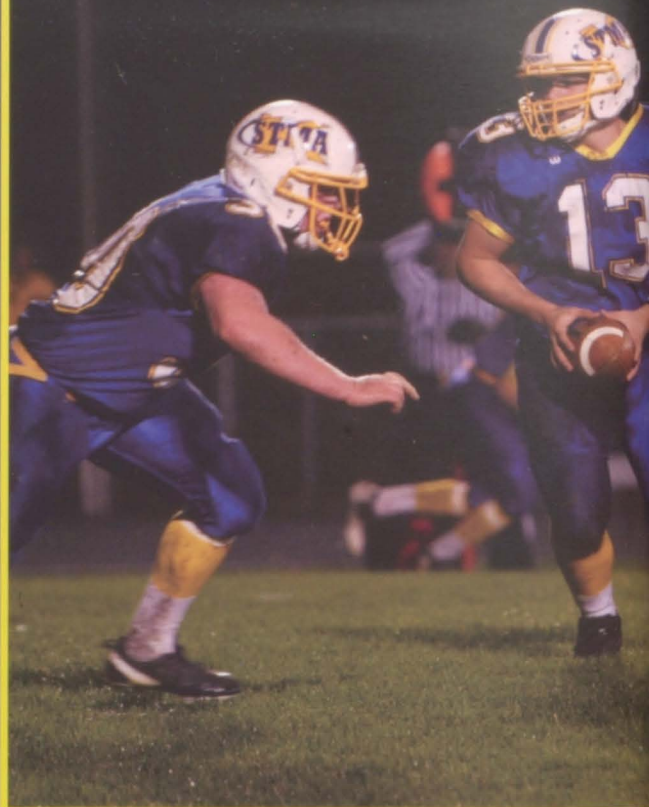

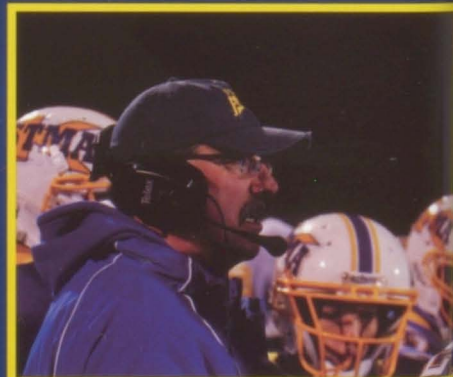

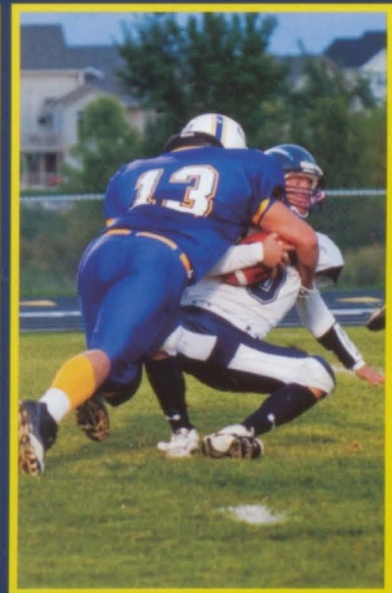

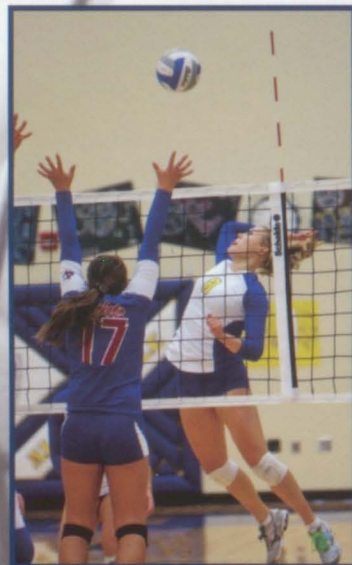

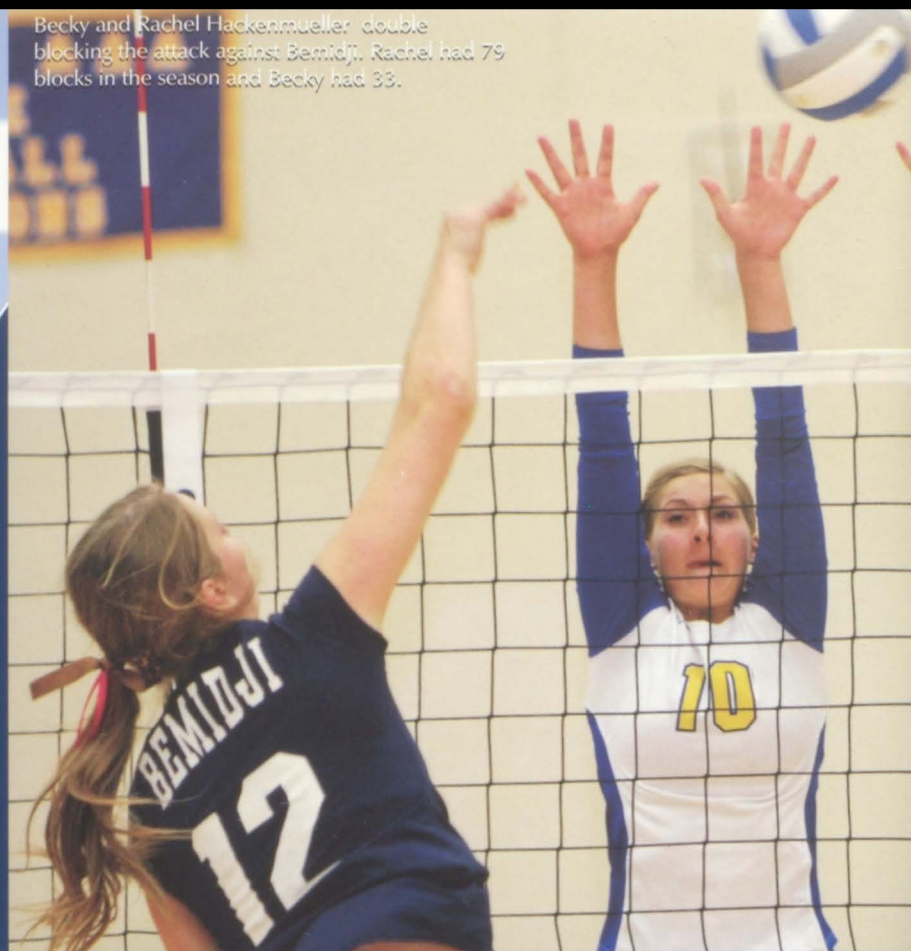

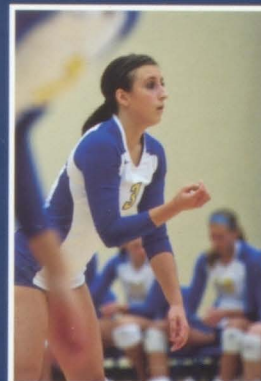

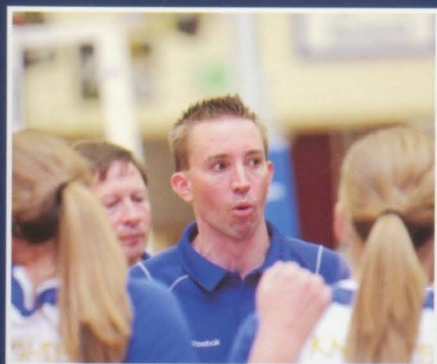

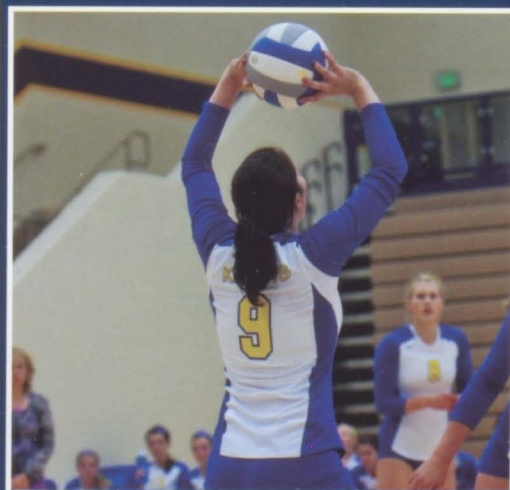

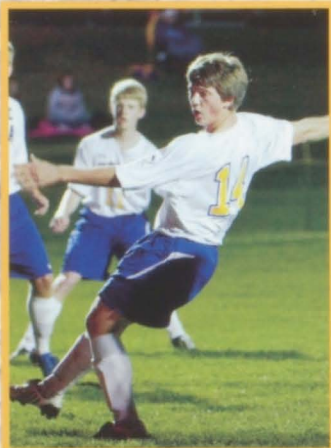
The team met together for their end of the season banquet; for the seniors it was their last soccer-related event of their high school careers, which brought many emotions.

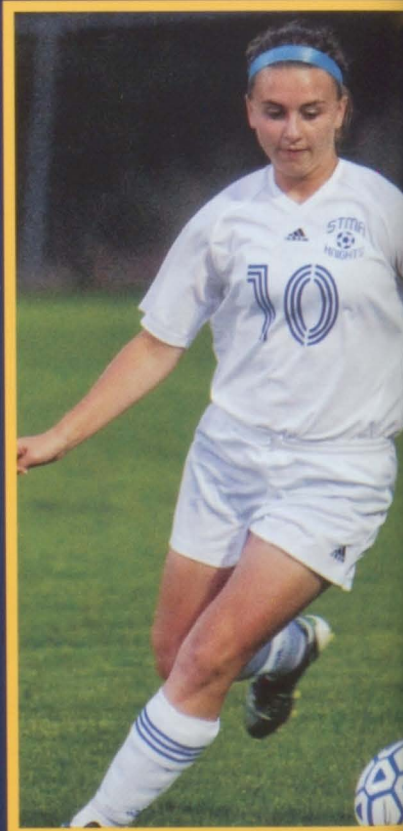

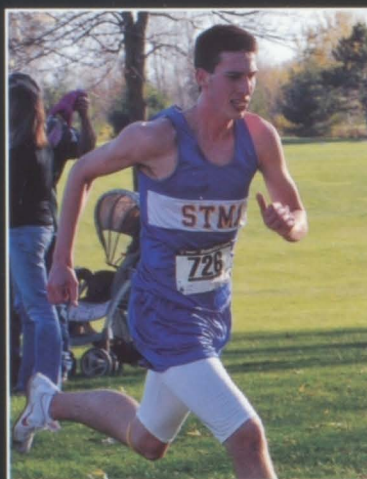

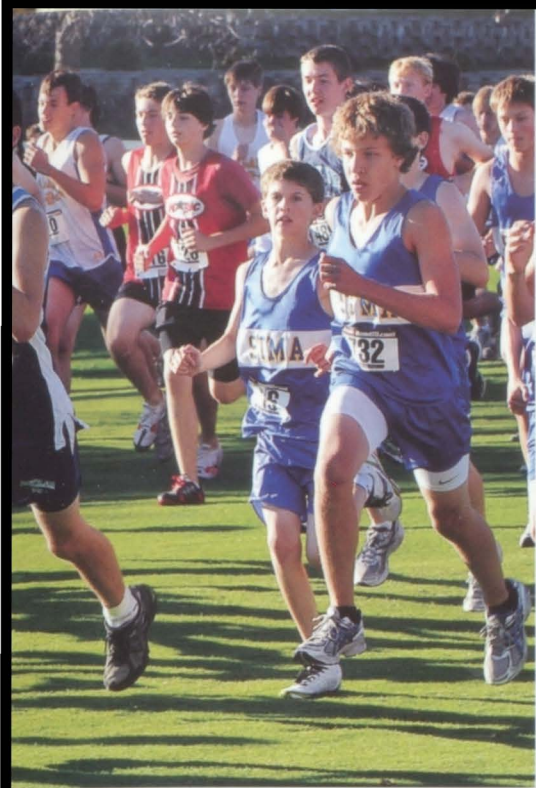

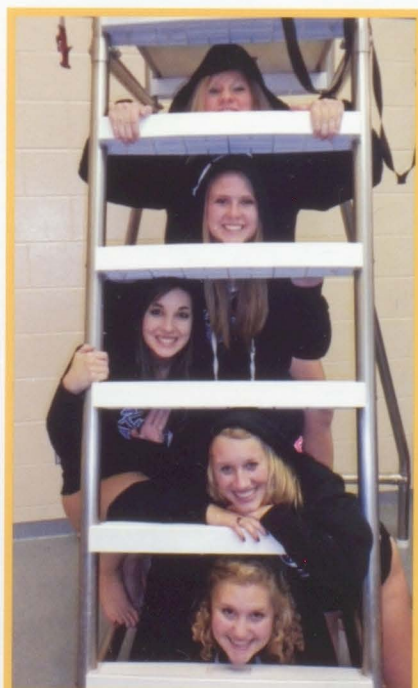

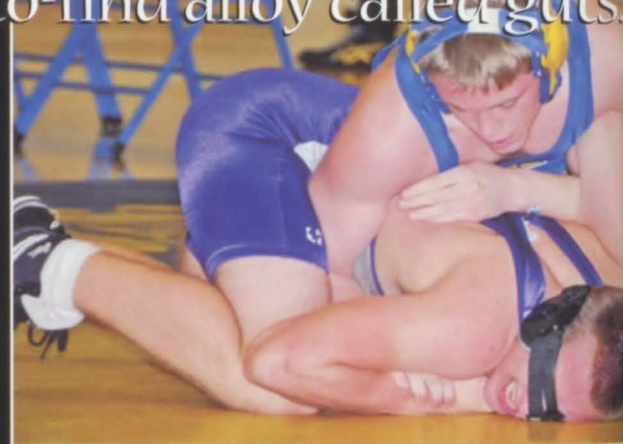

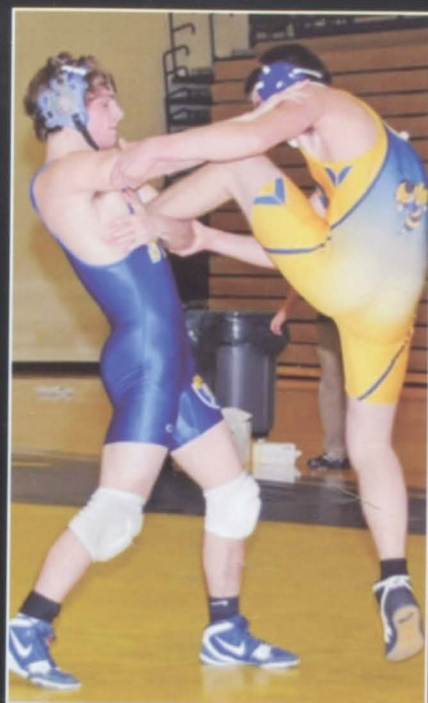

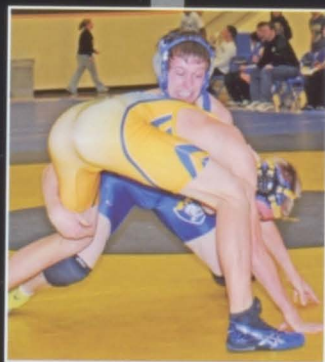

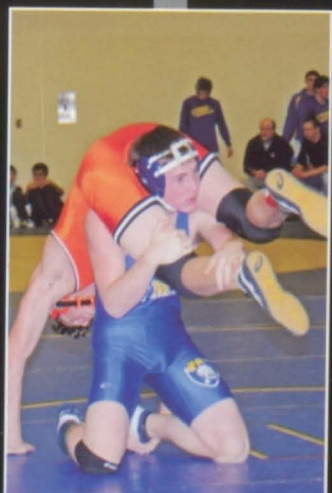

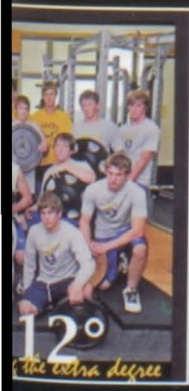

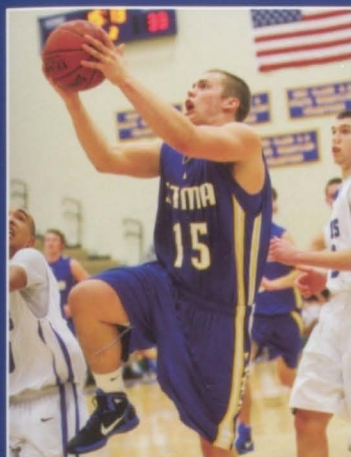

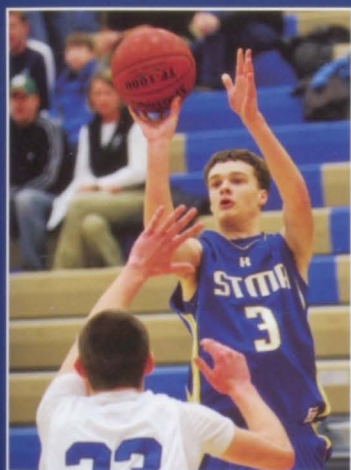

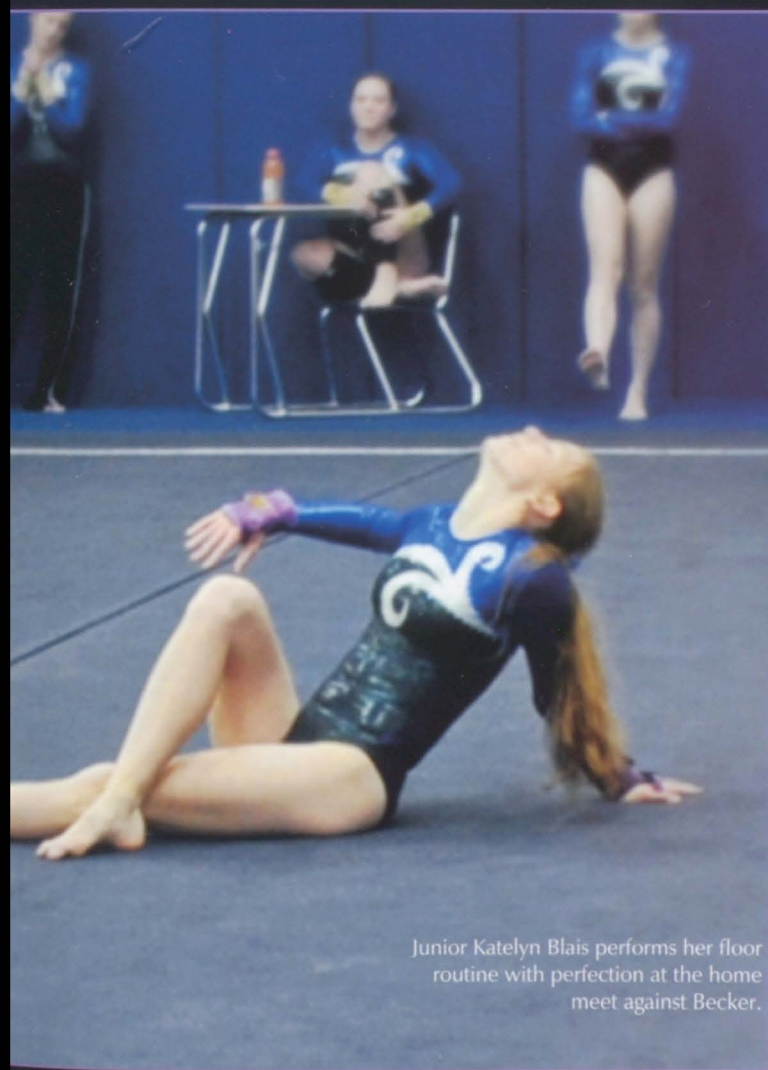

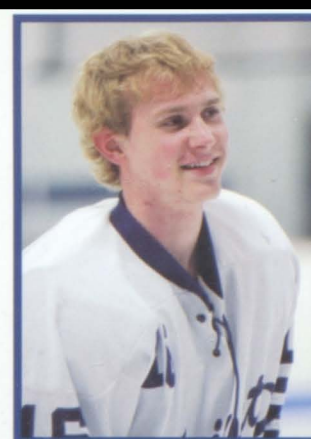

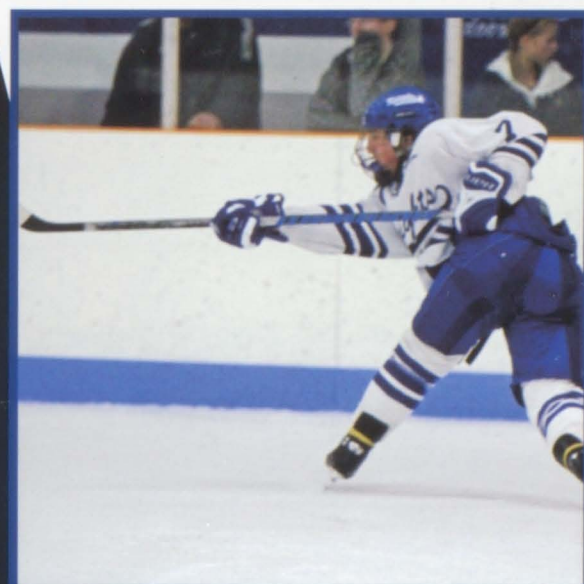

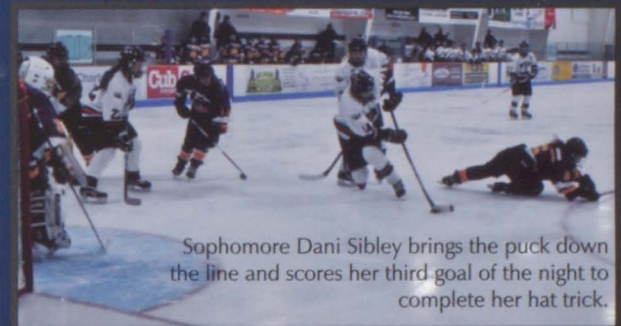

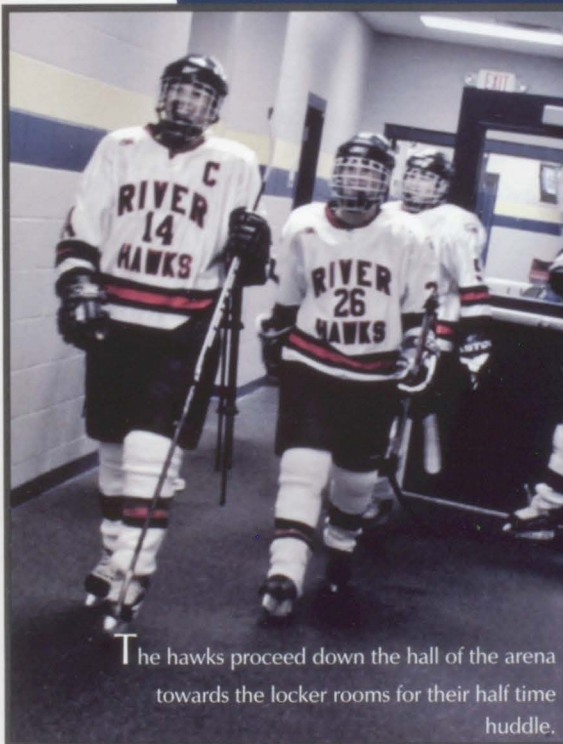

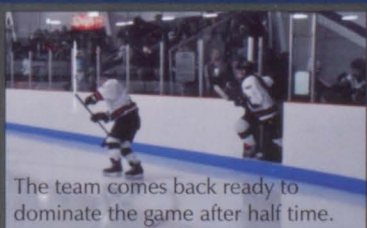

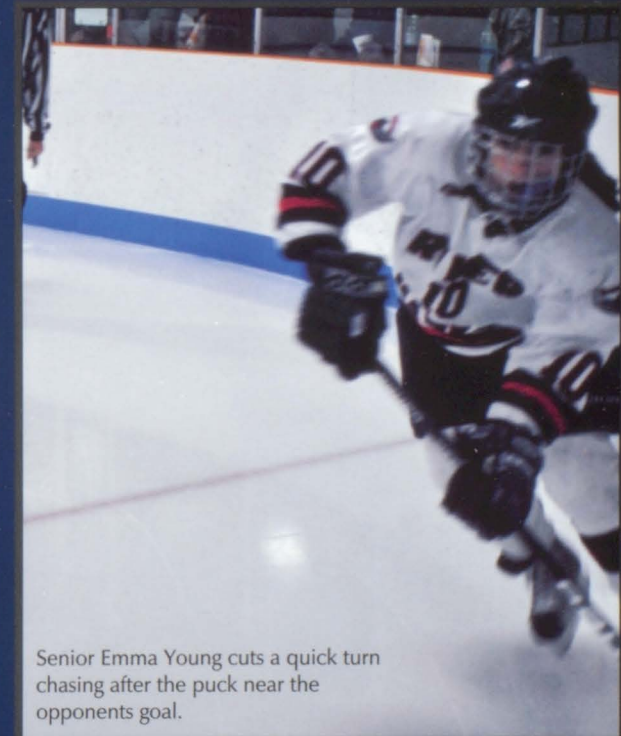

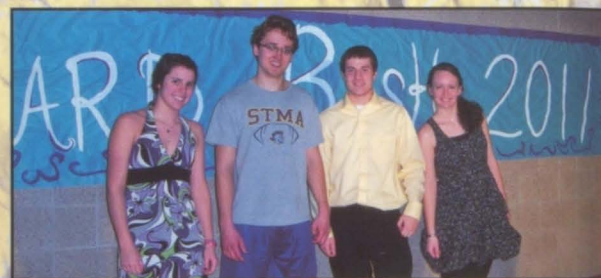
National Honor Society

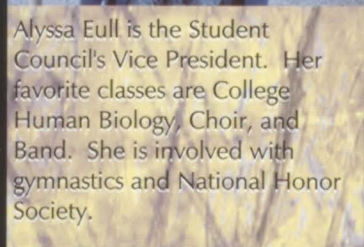

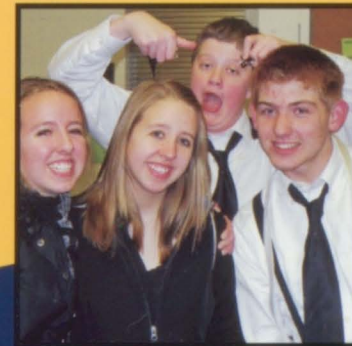

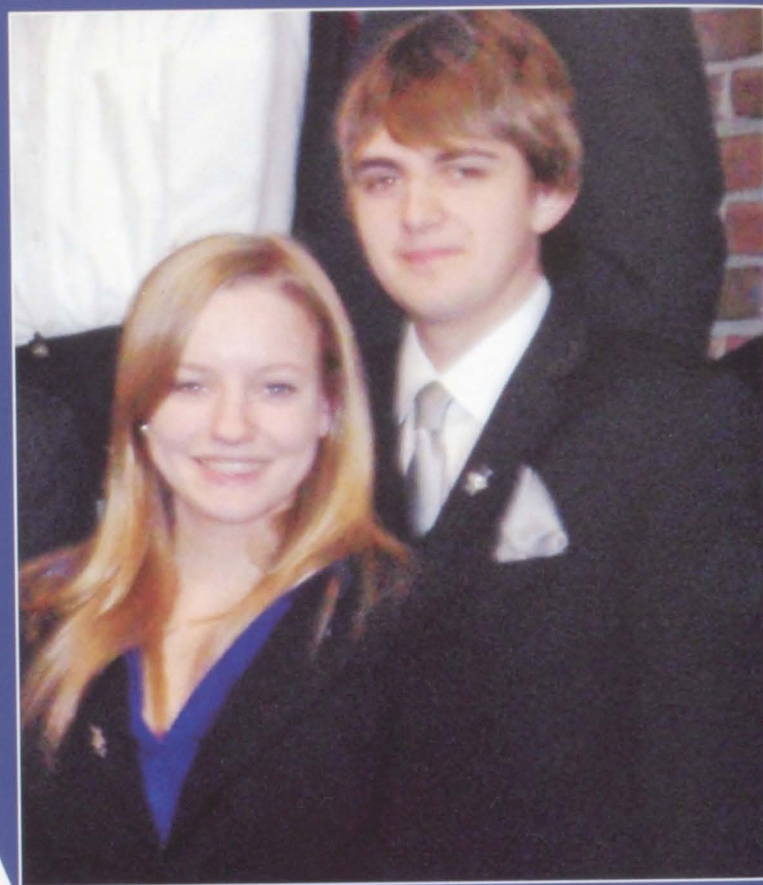
Little Italy *and Chinatown*

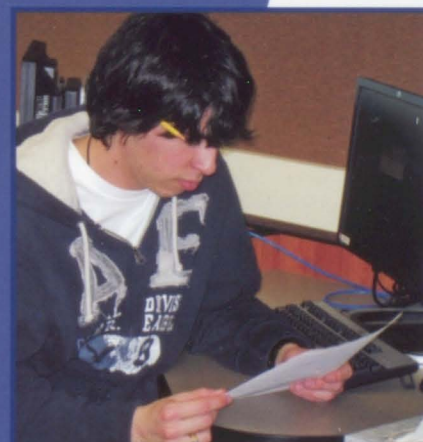
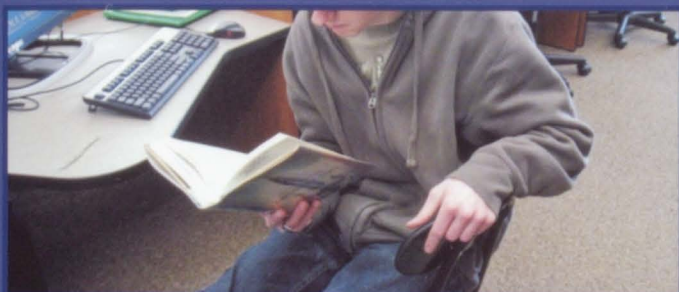
