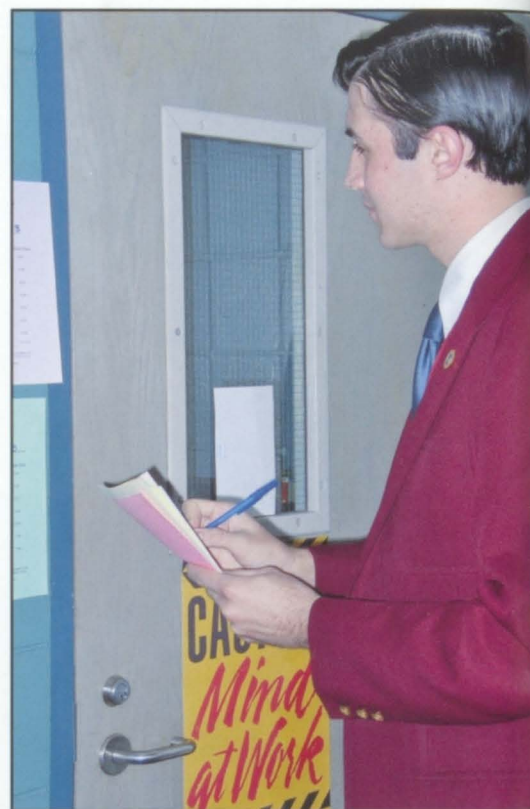


The Legend of the Teal Suit

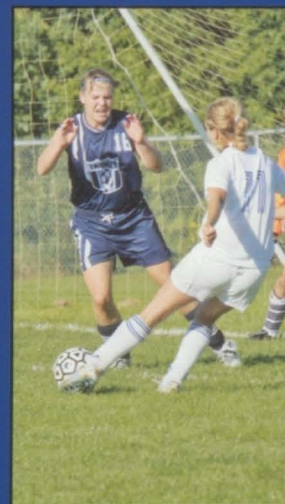

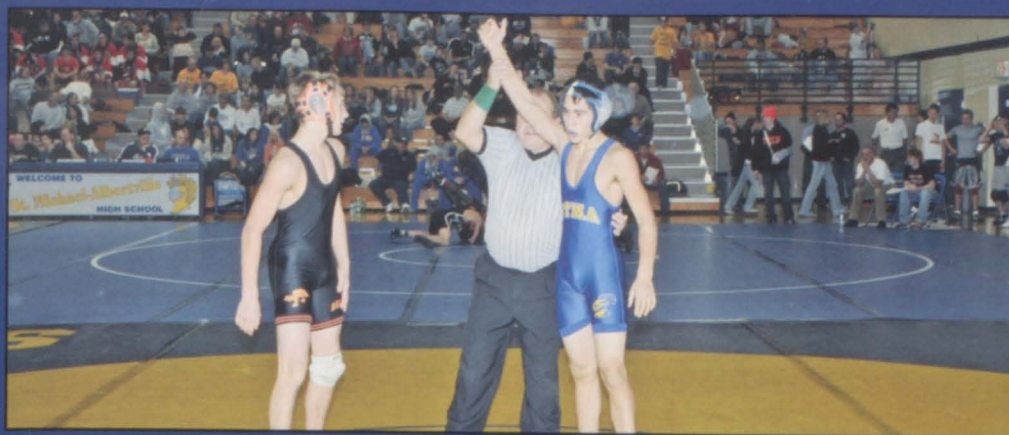


"FIRE UP FOR FIVE!"

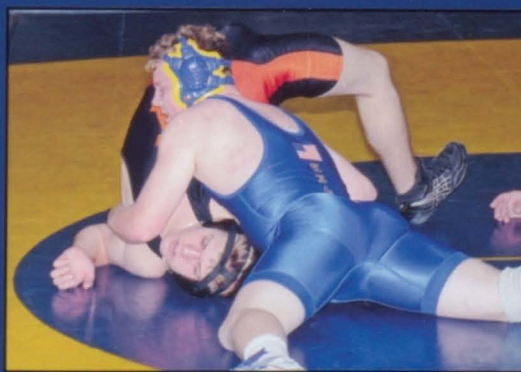

An example of one of the poetry pieces the whole club took part in creating. They each wrote individual sentences and then arranged them into a poem.



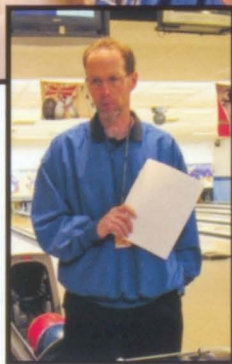

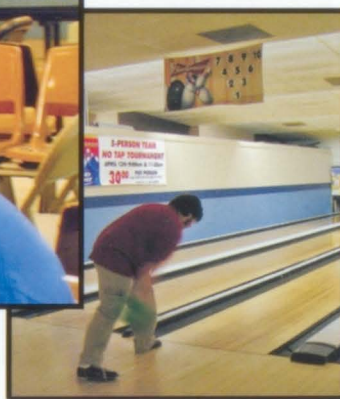
