


LETS PLAY FOOTBALLS The Knight football team capped a great 10-3

season with a trip to the metrodome. After losing two of their first four games, the Knights won eight games to storm into the State tournament. Along the way, they avenged their losses to Rogers and Becker, beating them both in the section tournament. In the first round of the state tournament the Knights hammered unbeaten Fergus Falls 32-14, to win the trip to the Dome. 


