The Knight football team capped a great 10-3 season with a trip to the metro dome. After losing two of their first four games, the Knights won eight games to storm into the State tournament. Along the way, they avenged their losses to Rogers and Becker, beating them both in the section tournament. In the first round of the state tournament the Knights hammered unbeaten Fergus Falls 32-14, to win the trip to the Dome. Mankato West defeated the Knights 38-14, scoring five unanswered touchdowns in the second half after the Knights had established a 14-3 lead early in the second half.

Junior running back Kwaku Amoah ran for 1171 yards during the season, while senior Jason Dehmer ran for 579 and completed 97 passes for 1397 yards. Dehmer was selected Mississippi 8 MVP. He also punted, played key downs in the defensive backfield, and returned punts. Senior Jordan Scherber caught 28 passes and was third on the team for defensive points. Juniors Kraig Schumm and Bryton Carlson led the team with 487 and 429 defensive points respectively.

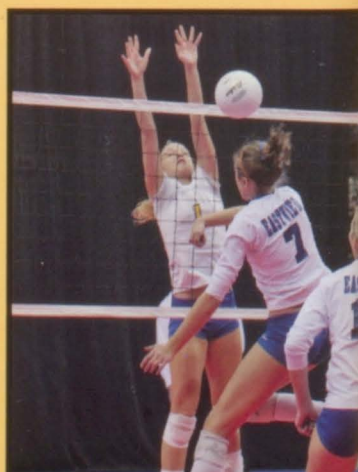

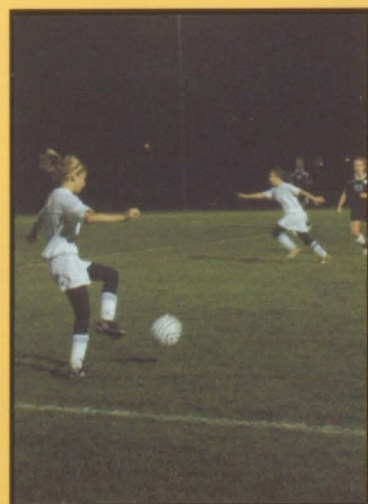

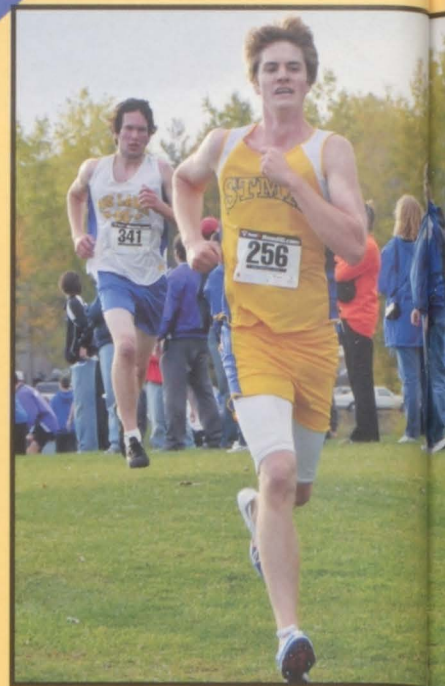
# OUR BEST RUNNERS GET THE LEAST PLAYING TIME

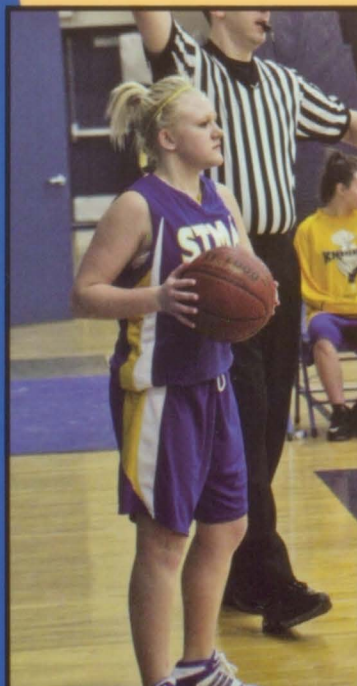
# DEFENSE, DESIRE, DESTINY

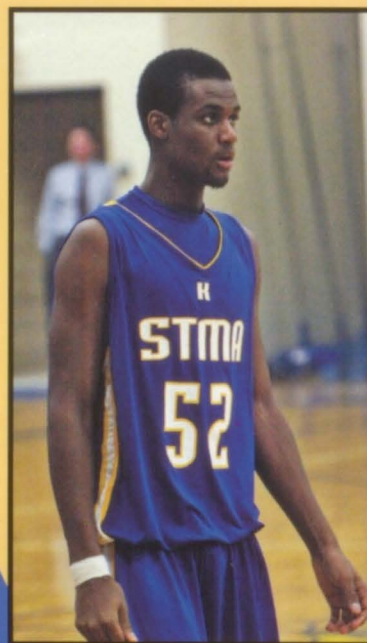
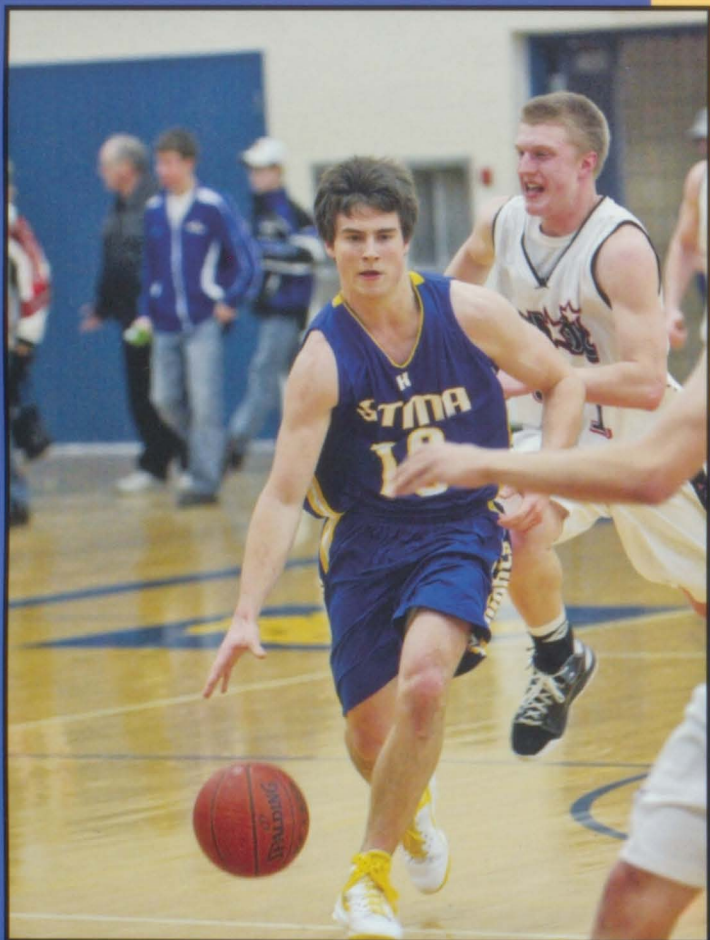


# BRINGING OUT THE BEST IN EACH OTHER!

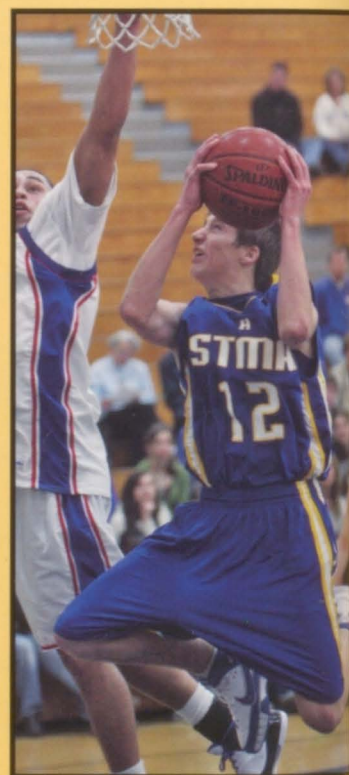

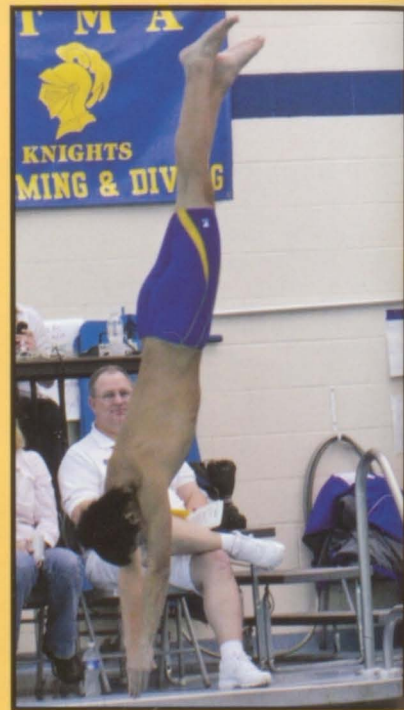
