##### **Summary**

Canterbury School seeks a student-centered educator for employment as an Academic Counselor and Head Girls' Varsity Lacrosse Coach for the 2024-2025 school year. The position is a full-time 10-month position and reports directly to the Director of the Donovan Center for Learning (DDCL). Responsible for managing the day-to-day administration of academic life and support at Canterbury while collaborating and problem solving with members in the Donovan Center clearly and respectfully. Strong preference will be given to candidates who played collegiate lacrosse, who have a coaching background in lacrosse (including film analysis and off-season training), and who have an established relationship with club/travel lacrosse organizations. Candidates must enjoy working with adolescents and maintain an exceptional work ethic, strong communication skills, and a commitment to collegiality. The position includes dormitory duty, extra-curricular activities, and assisting with a second coaching season to be determined. Housing/meals, medical coverage, and retirement planning are included in the benefits package.

##### **School Setting**

Canterbury School is a co-educational, boarding high school located in northwestern Connecticut, approximately one hour northeast of New York City. The school is comprised of approximately 325 students (of whom 70% are boarding), possesses excellent facilities, and is committed to the continuing education of its faculty.
