##### Summary

Canterbury School seeks a Head Girls' Varsity Lacrosse Coach for the 2024-2025 school year. The position can be part-time or can be combined with Academic Counseling as a full-time position. Strong preference will be given to candidates who played collegiate lacrosse, who have a coaching background in lacrosse (including film analysis and off-season training), and who have an established relationship with club/travel lacrosse organizations. Candidates must enjoy working with adolescents and maintain an exceptional work ethic, strong communication skills, and a commitment to collegiality.

The full-time position includes dormitory duty, extra-curricular activities, and assisting with a second coaching season to be determined. Housing/meals, medical coverage, and retirement planning are included in the benefits package.

Canterbury School is a co-educational, boarding high school located in northwestern Connecticut, approximately one hour northeast of New York City. The school is comprised of approximately 325 students (of whom 70% are boarding), possesses excellent facilities, and is committed to the continuing education of its faculty.
