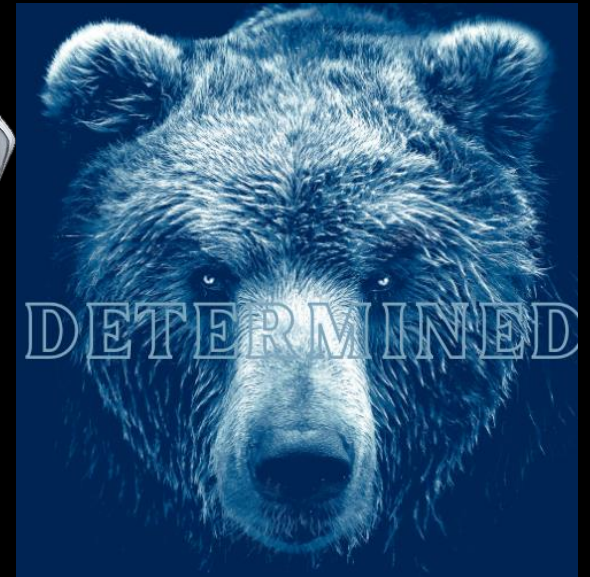

SENIORS OFF CAMPUS PRIVILEGE



Seniors can earn the privilege of going off campus for lunch without penalty.

To earn this privilege: Grades, behavior, attendance, and tardies will be monitored the first 4 weeks.

To earn this privilege, a senior must:

Have all grades 70 or above

Have no unexcused absences

Have 3 or less cumulative tardies (across all classes)

Have no behavior referrals that resulted in a consequence.

Administration has the discretion to remove this privilege due to a major infraction or multiple minor infractions. The criteria will be revisited each 9 weeks.

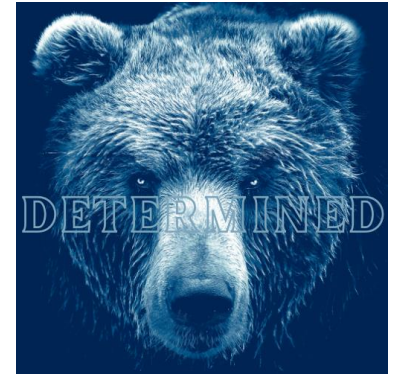
