ASSESSMENTS	Goliad Elementary School has common formative assessments that every teacher gives. No matter the teacher, each child is assessed via the same assessment which models each assessment after the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness or STAAR test. Previous STAAR tests are released and utilized for assessment and instruction in addition to other curriculums. Some forms of assessment include Istation, MAP, Short Cycle Assessments based on TEKS.
