At 7:05 p.m., Mr. Shephard called the meeting to order and asked those present to join in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Called to
order**

- ◆ Mrs. Anzalone thanked the 2017-2018 student representatives to the Board, Hailey Brenner and Emma Schiedel. Hailey will be attending Canisius College for three years, followed by medical school in Erie, PA. The 2018-2019 student representative will be Caroline Szufflita.
- ◆ Eden Elementary Student Projects – Several of Mrs. LaRosa’s staff and their students gave presentations on projects that they worked on.
 - Mrs. Ploetz introduced some fourth grade students who participated in Invention Convention. Two local inventors talked with the students about inventing; Mikayla Nelson invented doll prosthetics and Paul and Cindy Swisher invented a plastic piece to make Can Jam marketable. STEAM Night and the Invention Convention were held together. Eli Chimera invented a multi task table. Sophia Donovan invented a fruit fly repellent system with an apple, cotton balls and peppermint oil. Addie Donovan invented a doggie vest that could hold everything needed when walking a dog. In competition, Eden took a first and a third place. Sophia was one of twelve finalists.
 - Third graders, Brayden Baker, Garrett Walczyk and McKinley Lindstrom worked on preventing plastic pollution. They made a sculpture of a shark from plastic bags woven through chicken wire. Their sculpture was chosen for an Art exhibit. Wegmans donated reusable bags to the class.
 - Mrs. Walker asked three students to share their project. Sam Steward, Carleigh Wiles and Ciara Clark presented the rain barrel. Their theme was “No Plastic Would be Fantastic”. It was on display for a month.
 - Mrs. Steger and Mrs. Theophilus, along with Grace Canfield and Abby LaVerdi discussed their class project, supplying basic needs for refuge families. They donated items and \$850, of which \$515

came from an anonymous donor. The rest came from their campaign to donate a dollar to wear a hat in school.

- Mrs. DeGroat and Mrs. Flynn, with Emma Schmitt presented their class project, which was to collect clean, used plastic bags to weave into sleeping mats for the homeless. Bags were collected, sorted and cut into strips, then crocheted into mats. It takes 700-1,000 bags to make one sleeping mat.
- ◆ NYSCATE Presentation in Albany, NY – Mrs. Steger and Mrs. Theophilus gave a presentation on Personalized Learning. Mrs. Anzalone and Mrs. Kindley attended. Both agreed that Mrs. Steger’s and Mrs. Theophilus’ presentation was the best.
- ◆ NYSCATE Inaugural Class of National Board Fellows 2018-2019 Amy Steger was selected as a recipient.
- ◆ Yearbook – Mrs. Anzalone congratulated Mrs. Alessi Nicastro, Yearbook Advisor, and the students who participated in the making of this year’s book. It is one of the best she has ever seen. The theme was around the capital project, a story that will be there forever. It is clean, crisp and organized. Mrs. Alessi Nicastro said it was their mission to make it the best. She thanked Mr. Cuddihy for sharing his stunning photos. They would like to see a yearbook design class. Mrs. Anzalone suggested they share that with Mr. Przybysz.
- ◆ Erie County Comptroller, Stefan Mychajliw, gave a presentation on school consolidation. He stated that the County Executive’s timing on school consolidation was difficult. He quoted W. Edwards Deming, “In God We Trust, All Others Bring Data.” Mr. Mychajliw stated that it is a false idea that when schools consolidate, they can get rid of people and save money. In 1977, Buffalo, Tonawanda and Lackawanna signed an agreement for sales tax sharing. Any of the partners can terminate this agreement with twelve months’ notice. Thirty districts depend on this revenue. If all parties wish to consolidate school districts, it is a long process. The districts must commission feasibility studies, approved by their Boards of Education. The Districts must prove consolidation has community support through some form of straw poll or petition process. If consolidation was to move forward from there, New York’s Commissioner of Education would issue an order for consolidation with the new district’s boundaries. Based on feasibility studies, existing community support and the order from NSED, a formal referendum would be held that must pass in each community impacted. Consolidation would formally take place in July of the following year, if all parties passed the formal referendum. The County would have no say in any of the aforementioned steps. It is very possible that teacher salaries in the district where the salaries were lower, would be bumped up to meet the salaries in the other district. Taxes in each district would likely change; one district’s taxes may increase, while the other would decrease. Many residents do not like to feel a loss of identity. Depew, Williamsville and Sloan overwhelmingly rejected consolidation. Consolidation lowers capital costs only for relatively small districts (300 pupils) and costs increase substantially when two 1,500 pupil districts come together. Currently, school districts must show how they have saved 1% of their

2014-2015 tax levies. Savings must save the 1% of that levy over a three-year period. Districts are encouraged to share services. Eden has been sharing some services for several years with surrounding districts.

- ◆ Safety Presentation – Mr. Martin stated that the Commissioner’s regulations require a safety presentation, followed by a thirty-day wait. The safety plan can then be approved at a subsequent board meeting. The changes in Eden’s safety plan involve new personnel and changes in the building configurations. The Eden Police, New York State Police, Sheriff’s Office and Homeland Security personnel toured our district recently. There were some recommendations made. Monthly safety meetings will be held, as well as safety drills.

Mr. Shephard asked if anyone wished to remove any items from the consensus items. There were no items removed.

At 7:20 p.m., Mr. Sutfin made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Horschel to begin the Special Board of Education meeting. **Called to order**

The Board discussed the community input and the two options moving forward. Board members agreed to take the contingency budget off the table. Mrs. Horschel talked to NYS Department of Taxation, and they said STAR will not be affected. Property tax relief is based on a formula and changes every year. **Budget discussion**

Mr. Shephard and Mrs. Kindley were in favor of a .46% increase. Mr. Shephard stated that the gap could be closed by using reserves. Mrs. Anzalone said the safety package is important. The GPS cost is only \$3,000 per year. Our current social worker covers 1,400 students and is responsible for their mental health. Hall monitors are needed, so teachers can teach. A Greeter/Attendance person would watch cameras.

Mr. Shephard made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sutfin to take the motion for the Board of Education to adopt a contingency budget for the 2018-19 school year to fund legal obligations of the School District, expenditures authorized by statute, and other items necessary to maintain the educational program, preserve property and ensure the health and safety of the students and staff off the table. Carried unanimously. **Remove contingency budget motion from table**

Mr. Shephard made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sutfin for a .46 budget with a maximum of \$230,000 taken out of reserves to close the gap and go out for a re-vote. Discussion ensued. Carried unanimously. **Approved budget for revote**

Mrs. Horschel made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sutfin that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the 2018-2019 District Code of Conduct be approved. Carried unanimously. **Approved code of conduct**

Accepted proposition #2 Mr. Sutfin made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Kindley to accept Proposition #2 Acquisition of School Buses/Vehicles (and related machinery and equipment) from the May 15th Budget Vote and the election of Mrs. Horschel and Mr. Cuddihy. Carried unanimously.
