II. New Business

A. Appointments. RECOMMENDED MOTIONS:

1. **Appoint Music Teacher.** **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** “that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, **Peter Griesinger**, who is permanently certified in Music, is hereby appointed to a probationary position in the Music tenure area for a probationary period commencing on September 1, 2016 (or as soon as possible) and ending on August 31, 2019 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of Education Law, in order to be granted tenure, the teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least two (2) of the three (3) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Salary is based upon **ETA Contract, Master’s +30, Step 10.**”

2. **Appoint Elementary Teacher.** **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** “that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, **Heather Radder**, who is professionally certified in Literacy B-6, Early Childhood Education B-2 and 1-6, Students with Disabilities 1-6, Generalist in Middle Childhood Education 5-9, English Language Arts 7-12 and pending certification in Students with Disabilities 7-12, Generalist and Literacy 5-12 is hereby appointed to a probationary position in the Elementary tenure area for a probationary period commencing on September 1, 2016 and ending on August 31, 2020 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of Education Law, in order to be granted tenure, the teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Salary is based upon **ETA Contract, Master’s +30, Step 1.**”

3. **Appoint Elementary (Reading) Teacher.** **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** “that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, **Madison Hailand**, who is professionally certified in Literacy B-6 and 5-12, and Childhood Education B-2, and 1-6, and pending certification in Students with Disabilities 1-6 is hereby appointed to a probationary position in the Elementary tenure area for a probationary period commencing on September 1, 2016 and ending on August 31, 2020 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of Education Law, in order to be granted tenure, the teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Salary is based upon **ETA Contract, Master’s +12, Step 1.**” (SA) (ENC)

4. **Appoint School Board Attorney.** **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** “that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the firm of **Ferrara Fiorenza P.C.** be hereby appointed as school attorneys for the 2016-2017 school year.” (SA)

B. **Approve Funding for Coaches for Modified Lacrosse.** **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** “that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, funding for coaches’ stipends for boys’ and girls’ modified lacrosse teams at **Level IV of the ETA Collective Bargaining Unit** be approved. (SA)
