# Daily Activities Available at the Club

### Power Hour

*From 3:15 to 4:15, Monday-Friday*  
Students receive individual attention as they complete their daily homework assignments. Students who complete the most work each trimester are rewarded with a pizza party.



### Arts and Crafts

There are daily activities that cater to our members' creative sides. Some projects are sculpting with clay, drawing, and painting. Members are encouraged to be expressive through art.



### Games Room and Recreation Room Events

The Games Room and Rec Room are places for members to enjoy being members of the Club at their own pace. In these spaces, the Club offers daily structured programming and events, such as Minute To Win It, knee hockey tournaments, and Jeopardy matches; however, these are also spaces where members can choose to sit and play a game with friends.



### Daily Challenge and Outdoor Activities

Everyday, the Club offers different strength or teambuilding activities. Additionally, we strive to spend as much time outside as weather permits. This includes a flag-football league, pick up dodgeball and adventures on the Nature Trail.

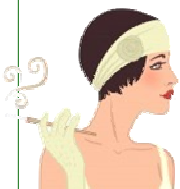
**Bash for Cash:**
