TRANSPORTATION:

Car Rider: We have two car lines. One in the front and one in the back of the school. Both lines are right entrance and exit only and have different colored car tags. Please make sure you are in the correct line. Please read updated dismissal information for more details. All students who are not zoned to Sampson will need to be in a car rider line for dismissal.
Walker or Bike Rider: Students may exit the building from the front (blue), near the playground (red), or the gym (green). Parents are encouraged to meet and escort their students. Kindergarteners must have an adult or older sibling meet them to leave.
Bus Rider: Only students eligible for bus service will ride the bus.





SCHOOL VISITATIONS:

We welcome your visits to Sampson. For the safety and security of our children and staff, all visitors must check in at the front office. Your driver's license or ID will be scanned and you will be given an personalized name tag for your visit which includes the are in which you are visiting.
Classroom Visits: Appointments are required and must be set up with the assistant principal. Visits are limited to 20 minutes. Parents or legal guardians may observe. The principal must approve any other persons observing.
Playground: Visitors are not allowed on the playground during the school day. Gates open each day at 6:00 pm for public use.
Lunch Visitation:
 The front office does not deliver lunches.
 ■ ■ Parents, legal guardians, and relatives (with a note from the parent) may come to have lunch with a student a total of 2 times each month.
 ■ Lunch may be brought in for your child only.
 ■ Students may not invite other children to eat lunch with them and their parent/guardian.
Lunch visits for Kindergarten may begin the 3rd week of school. 1st - 5th grade may begin lunch visits the 2nd week of school.

ATTENDANCE:

Students must bring a note signed by a parent with the reason for any absence. After a student is absent, parents may make arrangements with the teacher for make up work.
Arrival: Students should not arrive at school before 7:50 am unless asked by a teacher. Children will enter the building at 7:50 am.
Late Arrival: After 8:15 am students must report to the front office (accompanied by a parent) for tardy sign in.
Picking up students early: Parents must sign their child out in the front office. Students will be ready for pick up if the parent send a note with the student in the morning.
 Transportation changes can not be made after 3:00 pm.

<p>DISMISSAL: Regular - Weather conditions are normal or rainy. Inclement Weather - Weather conditions include strong wind, lightning in the area. Students must be a bus or car rider for Inclement weather.</p>	<p>CLINIC PROCEDURES: A parent must bring medicine to school. Please do not send it with your child. Medication must be in the original container properly labeled, with the child's name and directions for dosage. A written request to administer drugs must be on file. No medication can be sent home with students.</p> 	<p>CHANGE OF ADDRESS & TELEPHONE NUMBER: Please keep address and phone numbers up to date in the school office at all times. Notify us of any changes by sending a note with your child. In the event of an emergency, it is vital that we are able to contact you.</p>
<p>DRESS CODE: CFISD dress code will be enforced. (See student handbook) Please remember not to send students in flip flops. They become a safety hazard for PE/recess.</p> 	<p>LIBRARY NEWS: Sampson will have a district librarian on campus several days a week. Her name is Amy Mitton and she can assist with any library concerns. Students will have an opportunity to visit the library with their class once a week. They will also have book talks with the librarian. Students will be required to pay for lost or damaged library books. Be sure and ask your child about the books they are reading.</p>	<p>BIRTHDAYS: Every child is special. Due to state regulations, please do not send cookies, cakes, balloons, or other birthday treats to school.</p> <p>At Sampson, each student may say his or her name on the announcements. Birthday students will also receive a special treat from Mrs. Motzny.</p> <p>Parents may send birthday invitations to school ONLY if every child in the class receives one. Invitations should be delivered to the teacher to distribute in this case. We do not allow birthday deliveries for students.</p>
