Commencement Exercises - 2023	

Commencement Exercises

To be eligible to participate in commencement activities and ceremonies, a student shall meet all state and local graduation requirements, including all applicable state testing. [See EI, EIF]

Student participation in commencement exercises will be on a voluntary basis. An eligible student who chooses not to participate will receive his or her diploma in the mail. Eligible students who choose to participate in the ceremony must sign a commencement participation commitment and abide by the following regulations:

- Misconduct, distractions, or defiance of commencement procedures will not be allowed. Students
 who do not comply with the rules will be removed from the commencement activities. The
 administration will conduct class meetings to ensure understanding of the rules of conduct at the
 ceremony.
- 2. Students will comply with the commencement dress code. An inspection will be conducted before the processional. Those students in violation will not be allowed to participate in the program.
- 3. The Student Code of Conduct and all policies relating to student conduct that are applicable in the school will remain in force until the end of commencement activities.
