MEDICATION POLICIES

- All medications need to be brought to the school nurse by the Parent or Guardian. Medications **MUST** be in the original labeled container.
- If a medication is ordered by a Doctor for once a day, the Parent needs to give the medication **BEFORE** coming to school.
- If a medication is order by a Doctor every 12 hours or twice a day, the Parent **MUST** give the medication **BEFORE** school and before bedtime.
- If a medication is ordered three times a day, the Parent **MUST** give the medication before school, after school, and before bedtime.
- The School Nurse is **NOT** allowed to administer any medication that comes from outside the U.S.
- Medications not picked up by the Parents by the end of the school year will be destroyed at the end of the last working day.
