Short Course Description:	This course is designed to prepare the individual to take the Ohio State Tested Nurse Aide (STNA) registry examination. The student will learn through lecture, hands on laboratory, practice and clinical experience at a long term care facility. Topics include but are not limited to: legal and ethical issues, communication skills, universal precautions, safety and preventative techniques, basic nursing skills, nutritional information, and cultural issues. Upon successful completion of the course and passing the written/clinical examination the graduate will be placed on the Ohio Department of Health STNA Registry.
