

Truck Driver Training – Class B 2024-2025

Short Course Description:	The commercial driver (CDL) curriculum is designed to train students for entry level employment in the transportation field. This course blends curriculum prepared by J.J. Keller with the Ohio Commercial Driver Manual and is approved by the Ohio Department of Public Safety. Students will study control and vehicle systems in a classroom/lab setting. Examinations monitor students' progress, along with performance demonstrations in the hands-on portion of instruction.

Entrance Requirements:	All payment arrangements for program must be completed prior to the start of class; submit a Driver Abstract, and a copy of a valid Class D driver's license.

Job Placement Rate:	71%
Program Completion Requirements:	Complete all hours in order to test for CDL license.
