Alyssa Stubblefield – Shared information regarding her programming referenced below:

The Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC) program is for individuals between the ages of 15 and 30 who are experiencing psychotic symptoms. The individuals enrolled into the program will receive out-patient evidence-based practices delivered by a clinical team specialized in early psychosis.

## Services offered include:

- Psychotherapy, including Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Psychosis (CBTp)
- Family education, support, and involvement
- Support from peers in recovery from mental illness
- Psychotropic medications prescribed by a psychiatrist
- Support for education and employment goals

Research suggests that the sooner treatment is initiated after a first episode of psychosis, the more likely the person will experience significant recovery. The goal of the CSC program is to promote engagement and participation in treatment, foster recovery, and reduce or prevent disability.
