Students involved in extracurricular activities are required to participate in the random drug/alcohol testing program.

I understand that participation in an extracurricular activity is a privilege that may be withdrawn for violations of Brownwood ISD Board Policies. I understand that extracurricular activities include but are not limited to: all UIL activities; school-sponsored student groups/clubs/organizations; student council; all elected/appointed student officers; and non-curriculum-related student groups.

I agree to and shall indemnify and hold harmless the District, its officers, agents and employees, from lawsuits and liability of every kind, including expenses of litigation, court costs, and attorney's fees for injury or damage which I or my child or any other person might sustain as a result of my child's participation in the random drug/alcohol testing program.
