**Shared Klallam Language Teacher Agreement between**  
**Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe and Port Angeles School District**

This Appendix B is for an agreement of shared Klallam Language Teacher entered into between Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe (hereinafter “LEKT”) and the Port Angeles School District (hereinafter “PASD”) in accordance with this MOU for July 2023 through July 2025.

**Whereas,** the sole purpose is to continue the revitalization of the Klallam Language and Culture by offering it within PASD.

**Whereas,** a LEKT employee hereafter referred to as the shared KLT (Klallam Language Teacher) will teach Klallam Language and Culture at Stevens Middle School (hereinafter “SMS”) one period a day for the duration of the 2024 to 2025 school year.

**Whereas,** this Appendix B will be renewed annually in order to seek other funding sources to support a KLT at SMS.

**Whereas,** the shared KLT will abide by PASD policy and procedures to meet state and federal standards set forth specifically for a Native American Language Teacher to be teaching within Washington State Public Schools.

**Whereas,** the shared KLT will be supervised by the school principal during their teaching time at SMS. The school principal will report to the shared KLT’s LEKT supervisor regarding progress, attendance, and any issues that may arise to ensure quality work is being carried out.

**Whereas,** the SMS principal will contact the shared KLT's LEKT supervisor in a timely fashion to resolve any issues that occur to set up a meeting as soon as possible to keep regular business progressing.

**Whereas,** the shared KLT and their supervisors will hold a quarterly meeting to keep communication open.

**Whereas,** the shared KLT agrees to create a curriculum that supports the goal of keeping Klallam Language and Culture thriving and inspires the students to continue learning Klallam Language and Culture in their high school career and beyond.

**Whereas,** if at any time the shared KLT feels they cannot fulfill their job duties at SMS, they must turn in a written statement to PASD and LEKT as soon as possible. The shared KLT agrees to continue working at SMS as the Klallam Language Teacher until another certified Klallam Language Teacher can fulfill the position.
