


1. Go to Spotlight in the top menu bar and search QuickTime



2. Double Click the Icon to open a QuickTime.


3. Click File new movie recording.


Using QuickTime Audio Recording




1. Go to Spotlight in the top menu bar and search




- 2. Double Click the Icon to open a QuickTime.

Using QuickTime Screen Recording




1. Go to Spotlight in the top menu bar and search QuickTime




2. Double Click the Icon to open a QuickTime.

3. Click File New Screen Recording




4. To record click on the red record circle in the middle. To stop recording, click on the same circle— this time it will have a black square in the center.
