Please don't hesitate to reach out to me with any questions or concerns as we continue to navigate these challenging times together.

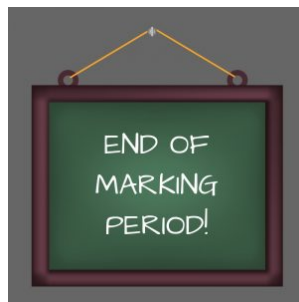


Family Membership sign-up is open! We are so excited for the school year to begin and your \$5 per family membership fee goes a long way to help us provide programs, materials, and events at our schools.

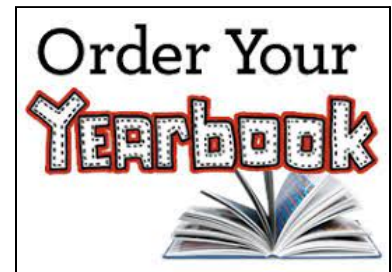
