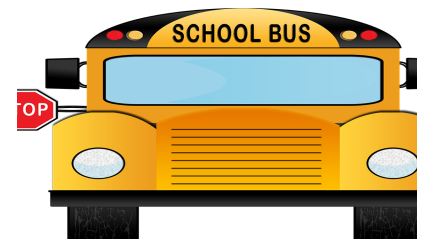
Drop Off & Pick Up
