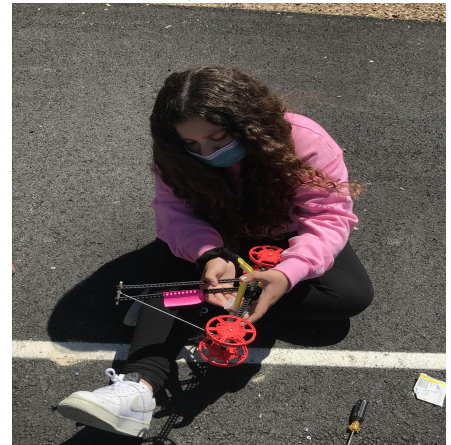

Family Life

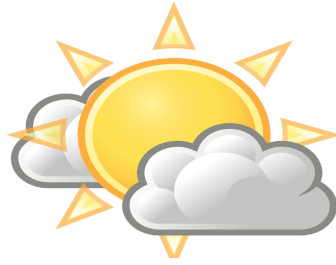
During the week of May 17th, 2021 we will be covering Family Life during Health Education with the fourth & fifth grade students.
