I hope this Newsletter finds everyone well and in good health.

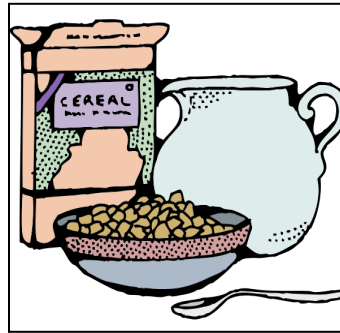
Please be advised that school picture make ups will be taken on Thursday, May 13th.

Drop Off & Pick Up

Please be advised that drop off is in the rear of the building and occurs between 8:15 a.m. and 8:45 am. Please exercise caution when dropping off your children. 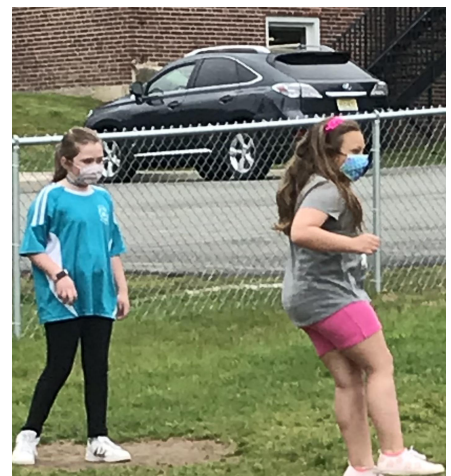

“Any pupil whose parent or guardian presents to the school principal a signed statement that any part of the instruction in Family Life Education is in conflict with his/her conscience or sincerely held moral or religious beliefs, shall be excused from that portion of the course where such instruction is being given and no penalties as to credit or graduation shall result there from.”

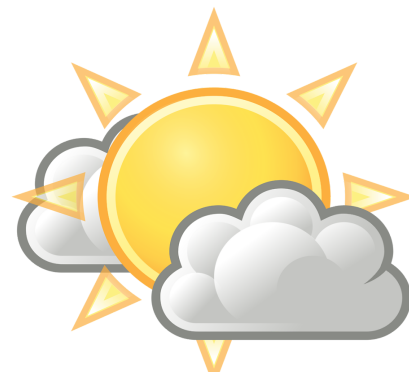
