As you are aware, beginning Wednesday, November 25th the Sussex-Wantage Regional School District will be switching to *full remote instruction* through Friday, December 11th. Although this period of remote instruction may eventually be extended based on DOH recommendations, at this time, we hope to resume in person instruction on Monday, December 14th while continuing to follow our cohort A or B model.

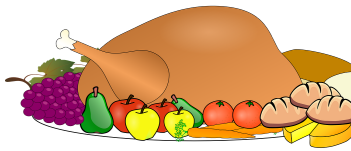

Clean: Always wash your hands, cooking surfaces, fruits, and vegetables. Do not rinse raw poultry before cooking.

Separate: Use different cutting boards as you prepare. Don't let bacteria spread from one food to another.

Cook: It is the internal temperature of the food that determines if it is done. Color is not an indicator of doneness.

Chill: Leftovers should be put in the refrigerator within two hours of finishing your meal to stop the growth of harmful bacteria.

Drop Off & Pick Up

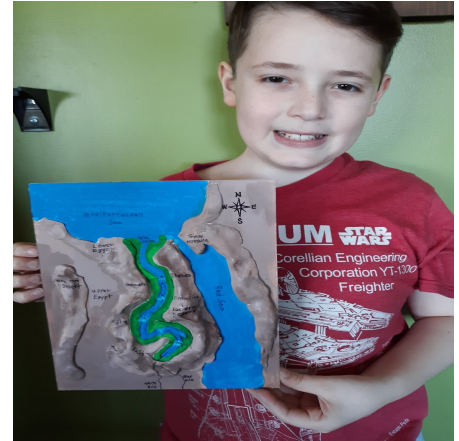
