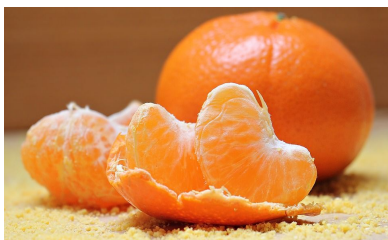
Food of the Month

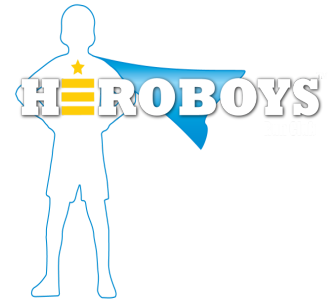
