

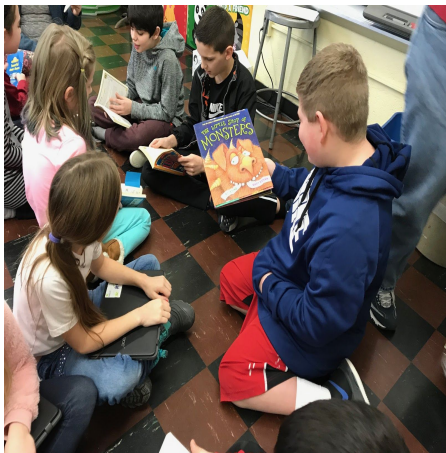

Scoliosis Screening for 4th Grade

There will be a scoliosis screening for students in Ms. Leanzo's, Ms. Orinski's and Ms. Veltri's class, on Wednesday, February 13th & Thursday, February 14th. A student may be exempted from screening, upon written request from a parent/guardian.

The screenings are state mandated and will be performed by the school nurse.

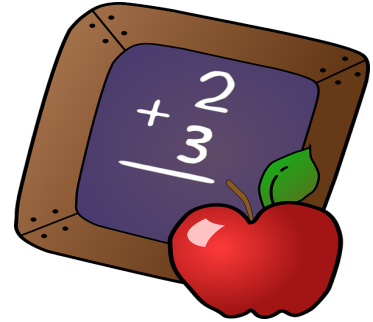

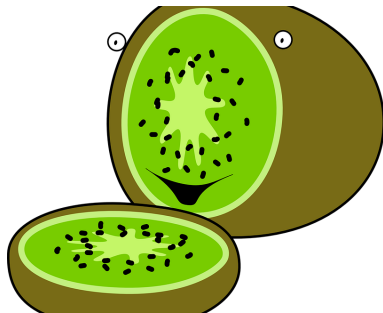
Food of the Month
