ImPACT® Testing



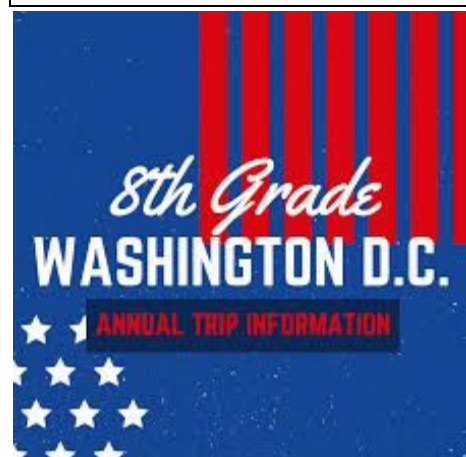
